The Sportsmen's Show and the Fly Fishing Forum has every one geared up for the upcoming angling season; there are many species to angle for and every one has a favorite.

This spring, 30 salmon in Lake Ontario will be wired for sound. The action starts in mid-April, when members of the Ontario Charter Boat Association and the St. Catharines' Game and Fish Association will fish for coho and chinook in the western basin of the lake.

They'll choose 20 coho and 10 chinook salmon for a radio tracking program which, by monitoring "beeps" from transmitters on each of the fish, will determine their whereabouts throughout the summer.

Natural Resources Minister Alan Pope said that this work is part of his ministry's Community Fisheries Involvement Program. The ministry will contribute \$25,000 and expertise to the project. The two associations will supply an additional \$10,000 in boats, and volunteer manpower to track and assist ministry staff in attaching transmitters to the fish.

The transmitters are about the size and shape of a tube of lipstick. The fish can be tracked individually as each transmitter has a different frequency: the transmitters will also record water temperatures at different depths in the lake.

Lake Erie Salmon Hunt

The dates for the Lake Erie Salmon Hunt are from July 7 to July 27. The total prize package will be about \$30,000 and \$18,000 of that will be won by the person

catching the largest salmon or trout. Additional prizes will be awarded in 14 categories. As an added bonus 30 to 40 draw prizes will be claimed by lucky entrants. The entry fee is \$10 per person with net proceeds of the tournament to be used in the club's fisheries enhancement program, and for charitable donations.

Organizers suggest early registration to guarantee a spot in the event which is expected to draw 1800 entries.


