# Autofest '84 at AHS aids Big Brothers

This year's Halton Hills Street Machines auto show in aid of Big Brothers promises to be bigger and better than last year's initial project. Spokesman for the local club, Paul Tobin of Acton, explained many car clubs in Ontario stage shows to help out Big Brothers. The show, entitled Autofest '84, takes place at Acton High School on June 17 from 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. There will be rods, vans, street machines, four by fours, etc., on display. A much larger field of entrants is expected, Tobin explained, because last year

there were only trophies for first place in each class. This year however, there will be first, second and third place winners in each category. Another indication of increased interest, Tobin said, is that for the 1983 show there were just 14 pre-registered entrants, but this year there are already over 60. In 1983 there were 112 entrants and Tobin says they expect well over 200 for Autofest '84. The registration fee is \$6 for a vehicle and two people. Those who just want to go and see the cars will pay \$2, except children under 12 who get in free.

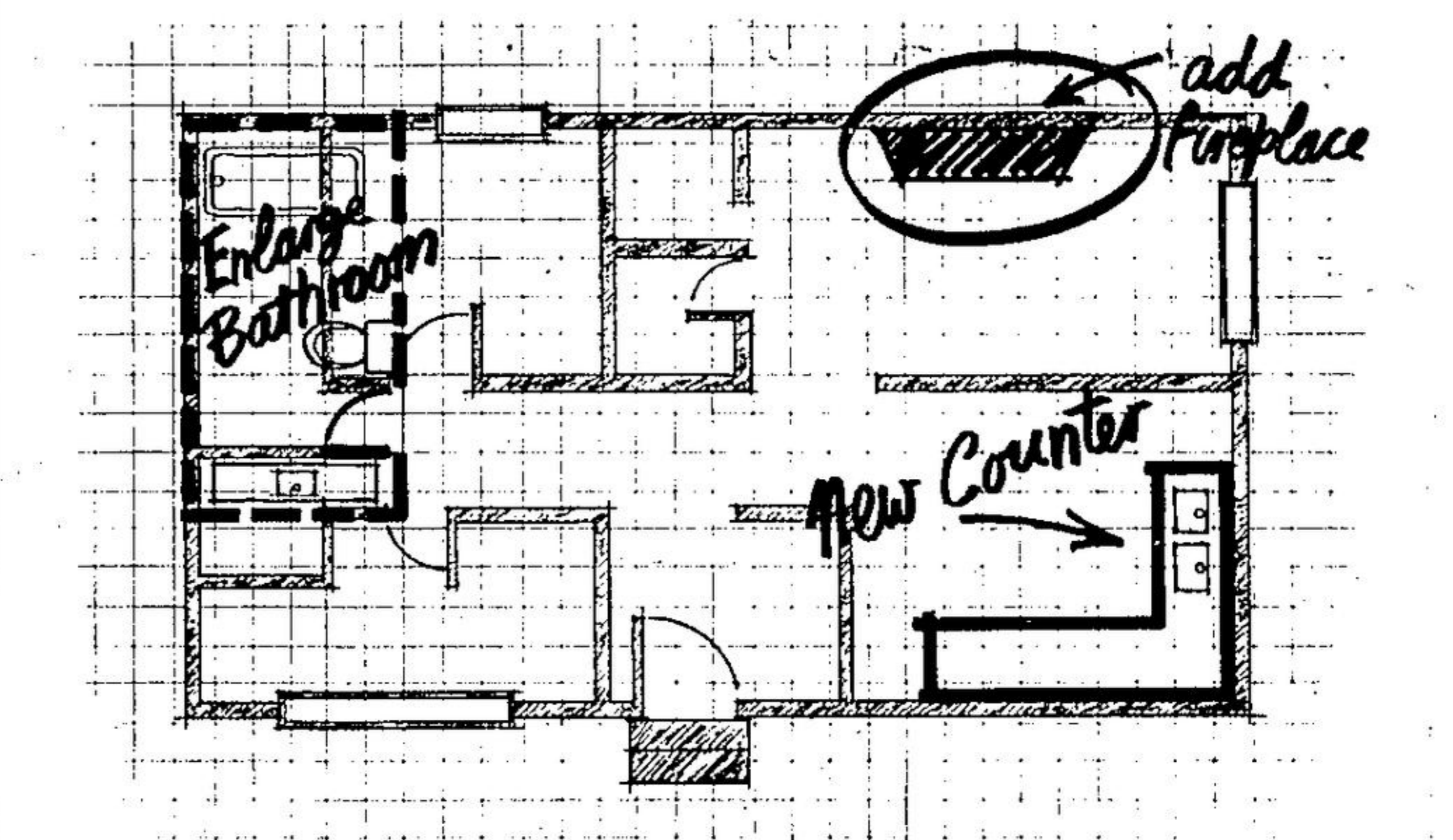
