RECIPE OF THE WEEK RHUBARB CRISP

FLOUR TOPPING:

2 cups sifted flour

1 cup brown sugar % cup butter

4 cups chopped rhuberb ROLLED OAT TOPPING:

% cup flour

1 cup rolled oats

% cup brown sugar

1/5 teespoon salt 15 cup melted butter

1 tesspoon cinnamon or grated orange rind

For flour topping, mix flour and augar; cut in butter until coarse crumb is formed. Mix about % of the crumbs with chopped fruit. Spread in well-gressed baking dish; cover with remaining crumbs. Sprinkle with grated orange rind, if desired. Bake in moderate oven, 350 deg. F., 30 to 40 minutes or until browned. Serve with

cream, if desired. For rolled out topping, combine ingredients and use as for flour topping. Baking time remains the same.

NOTE: If desired, you may use more rhuberb, depending on your testes.
