

Meeting here to plan 'Journey into Yesterday'

On July 24 a group of horseback riders will leave on "a Journey into Yesterday" from Depot Harbour, on Georgian Bay. On the 28th, another group of riders will leave from "Timbertown" on the Ottawa River.

Both groups, accompanied by other bicentennial celebrants using "traditional" forms of transportation, will converge on Whitney, Saturday, August 4th for a unique Ontario birthday rendezvous.

The journey will continue south and west and will wrap up with a Bicentennial Parade of Horses at the Bennett farm near Ballinacree August 25. The journey will cover 465 miles.

To inform the public of the projected schedule, meetings have been held in Renfrew and Hastings Counties and have been planned for Caledon East and Georgetown as well as Parry Sound and Emsdale. The Georgetown meeting is at Cedarvale gym on Monday, June 11 at 8 p.m.

The route and calendar will be outlined during these meetings and local residents will be encouraged to partici-

pate in the many events planned.

Historic, scenic and heritage routes will be traced and travelled by the participants of the journey. Descendants of the original settler families will be invited to sign a scroll and to record the name of the original settler family, their origin, date of settlement and land grant site.

Participants are expected to come from all age groups and walks of life. Some will be on horseback while others will participate on bicycle, by foot or by any traditional means. The celebrations will take place along trails, byways and the communities passed through.

This is a Bicentennial project of the Ontario Trail Riders Association (OTRA), approved and supported by the Government of Ontario, Ministry of Tourism and Recreation, the Office of the Bicentennial and the Ontario Equestrian Federation.

OTRA is an organization of horse enthusiasts dedicated to the development and preservation of multi-use, four-season recreational trails in Ontario.

Subject to council's approval later this month, Halton Region is now a patron of the arts.

Council's new art selection committee held its first meeting last week, recommending the adoption of a policy governing the selection and display of artwork at regional headquarters as well as other buildings under its jurisdiction.

Regional clerk Dave Varley, secretary of the new commit-

tee, told this newspaper that the need for such a committee became apparent in December, 1982, when regional headquarters hosted a display of work by local artists.

The Region currently owns about ten paintings, Varley said, including one donated by a retiring councillor last year. The committee will decide what art is to be displayed and where it will go.

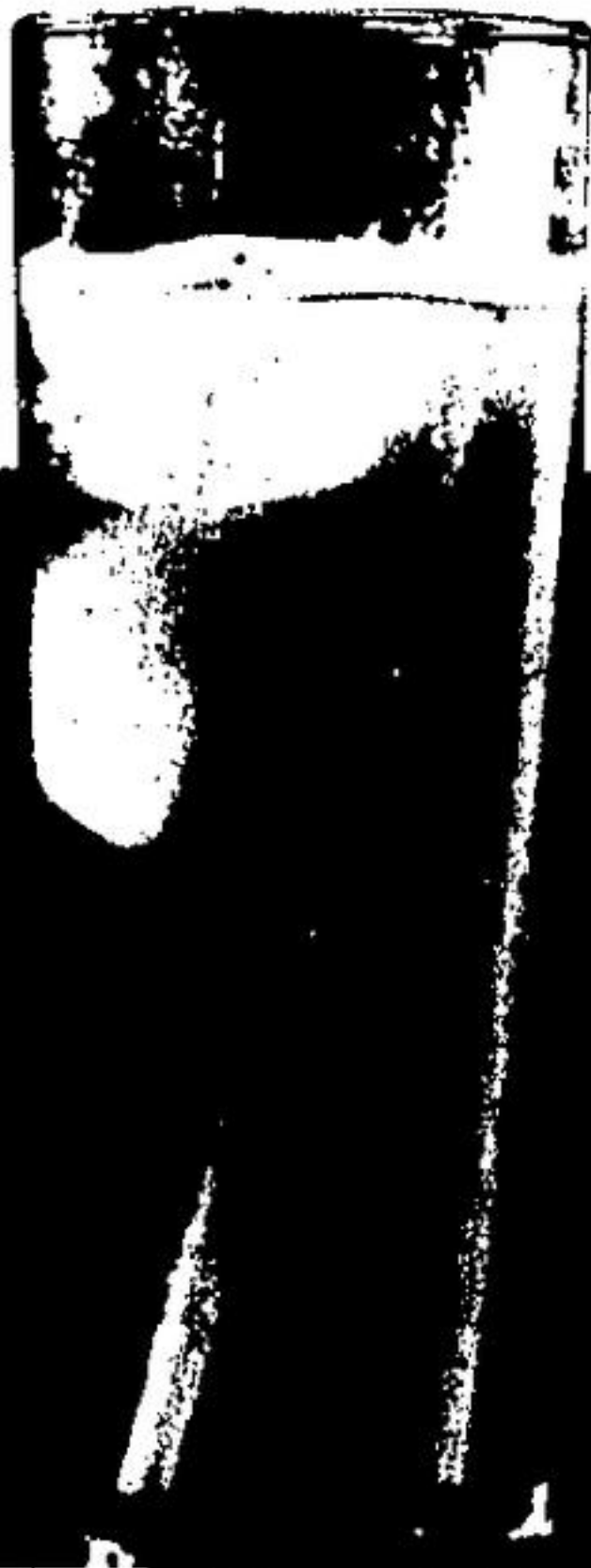
