Tips from the Golf

In discussing the take away (backswing) I'll look at various keys to use while the arms are moving back. In the next few weeks I'll be looking at the role of the arms in the takeaway, the role of the right side in the backswing, maintaining the posture position throughout the takeaway.

The takeaway is a product of our address position. If we have taken care in our prerequisites our takeaway has the opportunity to be strong and effective.

Its strength comes from the movement of the arms as the initial start. The front motion is from the upper arm and shoulder area. Because of our correct grip on the golf club, both arms are necessary to enhance the correct movement of the body as it travels throughout the swing.

We use the arms as the initial move because they are of a larger muscle group able to pull the entire body back into a position of strength and authority

The following are your checkpoints as the swing starts back. The first check is at the half way point. As the arms reach waist height on the way back; the lead arm and the golf club are parallel to the target line and body has moved very little. But, as the arms and shoulders continue to lift back they will pull the body into a position behind the back and the weight of the body supported on the right side.

Learn the correct initial motion first, for it will enable you to set up for that drive forward.

Next week I'll discuss the importance of the right side as the arms move back.


