Strike holds up British pensions

Canadian residents on British pensions have not received their cheques this month due to a computer operators' strike in the British office.

"The computer operators are not very happy with the shift system they have to work under," said a spokesperson for the British Consulate in Toronto.

The operators, on strike since the middle of May, are not demanding more money, the spokesperson said.

The consulate has heard no word about an end to the strike, she said. "It's indefinite." However, the British Consulate had not heard of the strike at all until Frank and May Voss, of Acton, both receiving British pensions, contacted Acton's social services and asked if they could help find out what had happened to their overdue cheques.

Social services phoned the Consulate, but they were unaware of the delay. The Consulate inquired about the strike and a course of action for those who have not received their cheques yet.

Send a letter explaining the circumstances along with the stub of your last cheque to: DHSS, Overseas Branch, Newcastle Upon Tyne, Ne981YX. This branch will attempt to get the cheque to you. If you don't have the cheque stub, send a letter explaining the situation and the amount of your last cheque.

People like the Vosses, who depend on their pensions to survive, were worried when their cheques didn't arrive and no explanation was forwarded. They knew

nothing about the strike. The Vosses are behind two cheques each.




