

# New business features fresh frozen produce

Fresh from the garden vegetables and fruits can now be bought here, packaged and frozen and sold in a new business on Highway 7, just west of Acton.

Using a flash freezing technique, Warren MacMillan sells fruits and vegetables which have been individually frozen in 30 seconds with liquid nitrogen immediately after being picked and processed.

This method, "captures more of the goodness than under a housewife's conventional way of freezing vegetables," says Macmillan.

In addition to preserving many of the nutrients that can be lost if fruits and vegetables are left unfrozen after picking, the flash freezing process allows each slice of fruit and each separate vegetable to be frozen individually, not all in one lump. The advantage is serving sizes can easily be adjusted without having to thaw too much or

MacMillan is supplied by a farmer's cooperative near his first business, MacMillan Orchards, in Whitby. The farmers pick, process, and freeze the fruits and vegetables which are then packaged in a plant in Trenton.

Each fruit and vegetable is sold in season and once the season is over for that one

particular item, MacMillan stops carrying it. The store opens June 21 this year, but plans are to open on June 1 in subsequent years. Asparagus and rhubarb are the two foods in season in June but July sees the beginning of the season for such things as peas, cherries, and strawberries. A seasonal chart and price list is available from MacMillan.

MacMillan's prices for asparagus are \$5 to \$10 dearer than the average supermarket in season, but, "we stress quality," he says.

He is able to choose the field of corn with the best quality ears out of all the fields available to him, he says.

MacMillan's store in Whitby has drawn customers from as far as North Bay and he expects to draw from as far as Kitchener to his store in Acton.

MacMillan will also sell cherries and apples processed and in their won juices, but not frozen. They are kept in a cooler at 32 degrees. These fruits cannot be frozen individually because of the moisture they emit when pitted. They are freshly prepared each

None of his food contains additives, save ascorbic acid (vitamin C) in the apples, and some sugar in the peaches, black cherries and apricots to prevent discoloration.


