Bateman show breaks even

The Robert Bateman exhibition on display at the Cultural Centre gallery through Aug. 3 has more than paid for itself, the Halton Hills Library Board learned last week. The board and the Friends of the Library spent \$2,864 preparing for the exhibit and its gala opening June 1, and recouped \$3,000 in patrons' donations and ticket sales for the opening. Still outstanding are revenues from the eventual sale of four prints from Bateman's first-ever etching and the sale of several remaining Bateman posters, worth \$25 each.
