**RECIPE OF THE WEEK**  
**STRAWBERRY-RHUBARB PIE**  
 1 1/2 cups sugar  
 3 tbsp. quick-cooking tapioca  
 1/4 tsp. salt  
 1/4 tsp. nutmeg  
 1 pound rhubarb, cut in 1/2 inch pieces (3 cups)  
 1 cup fresh sliced strawberries  
 Pastry for 9" lattice top pie  
 1 tbsp. butter  
 Combine first 4 ingredients; add rhubarb and strawberries. Mix to coat fruit. Let stand about 20 minutes. Turn into pastry-lined 9" pie plate. Dot with butter. Adjust lattice top, seal. Bake 400 degrees for 35-40 minutes.

**Nursing home named after L. and S. Bennett**

The nursing home slated for completion in September will be named the Bennett Health Care Centre, in memory of the late Letty and Stewart Bennett.  
 The naming was announced at the annual meeting of Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital Association, Thursday night.  
 In a report from Judge Ken Langdon, president of Georgetown Hospital Board, recalled the heliport giving access to larger medical centres was completed during the past year, and paid for by a grant from the provincial government.  
 He noted the board is continuing to seek Ministry of Health approval for the chronic care section of the nursing home, which has been roughed in, for completion when final approvals are obtained.  
 Langdon said the Hospital Auxiliary had again contributed to the hospital by raising \$15,000.  
 The board president said two new doctors had joined the staff over the past year.
