**'Ways of the Wood'
— summer day camp**

The Halton Region Conservation Authority is once again offering their summer day camp called 'Ways of the Woods', starting July 2-August 24. Ways of the Woods is designed to introduce children to the wonders of nature and native lore.

Participants are offered a one week nature program which includes activities such as canoeing, caving, and bird studies; or a two week program which includes nature studies as well as native lore studies, such as archaeology, Indian songs, dances and legends.

All programs are planned to utilize many of the Conservation Authority's natural and human resources. The base camp is Mountsberg Wildlife Centre with extensive use of Kelso, Mount Nemo, Crawford Lake and Rattlesnake Point Conservation Areas.

Registration forms can be obtained from the Halton Region Conservation Authority, 310 Main Street, Milton, Ont. L9T 1P4, or by calling 878-4131. A one week session is \$50/child while a two week session is \$100/child. Each additional child is \$45 per week.

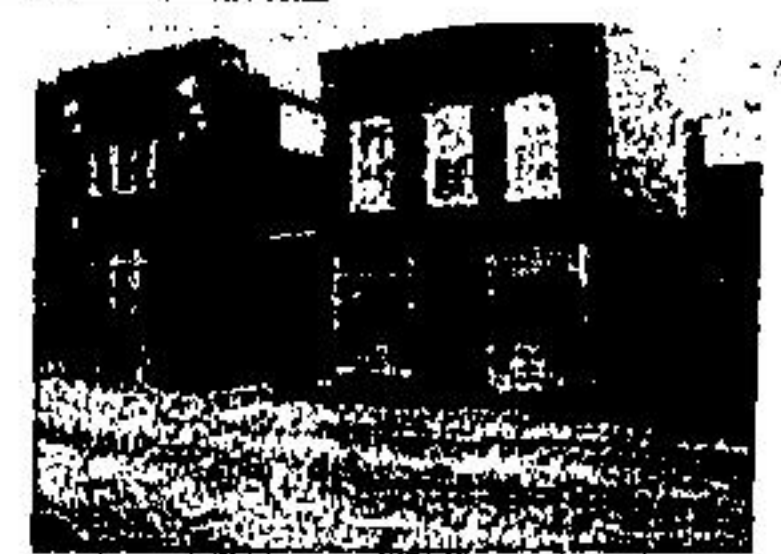
