## Police blotter

### Drivers uninjured

Both drivers escaped injury in a \$8,000 collision early Friday evening on Highway 24 near Brisbane. Cars driven by Eric Seiz, 19, of Lot 1 Concession 4 near Acton and Zdenek Novozamaski of Orangeville collided at an intersection.

### Major injuries

A 19-year-old St. Michael St. woman was taken to Guelph General Hospital with major injuries Thursday evening following a two-car collision in Ospringe. Guelph OPP say Theresa Wilson was a passenger in a car driven by Mark Goodlet, 22, of the same address, when the vehicle collided with another driven by a 72-year-old Waterloo woman. The second driver received minor injuries. Damages were set at \$8,000 to the two cars following the collision at the intersection of Highways 24 and 25. As of press time, Guelph General could not provide additional information about Wilson's condition.

### Boy hit by car

A nine-year-old boy received minor injuries when he was hit by a car while on his bicycle. The driver of the car, a 23-year-old Sunnyside Drive, Erin resident told police the bicycle was in the middle of the road at the top of the hill on 7th Line and her car was unable to swerve to avoid the youngster.

### Major injuries

A 19-year-old Georgetown woman received major injuries Thursday evening when the car she was riding in collided with a second vehicle in Ospringe. Guelph OPP report that Theresa Wilson of St. Michael St. was taken to Guelph General Hospital after the car in which she was a passenger was struck at the intersection of Highways 24 and 25. Driver Mark Goodlet, 22, also of St. Michael St., was uninjured, while Dorothy Weller, 72, of Waterloo, driver of the second vehicle, received minor injuries. As of press time, Guelph General Hospital could not provide additional information about Wilson's condition.

### Farm Accident

An RR 3 Rockwood man received "large lacerations" to his head when he was struck by the plunger of a farm baler he was helping repair June 28. Gord Wilson spent two days in Guelph General Hospital according to Guelph OPP, after the accident took place on a neighbor's farm.
