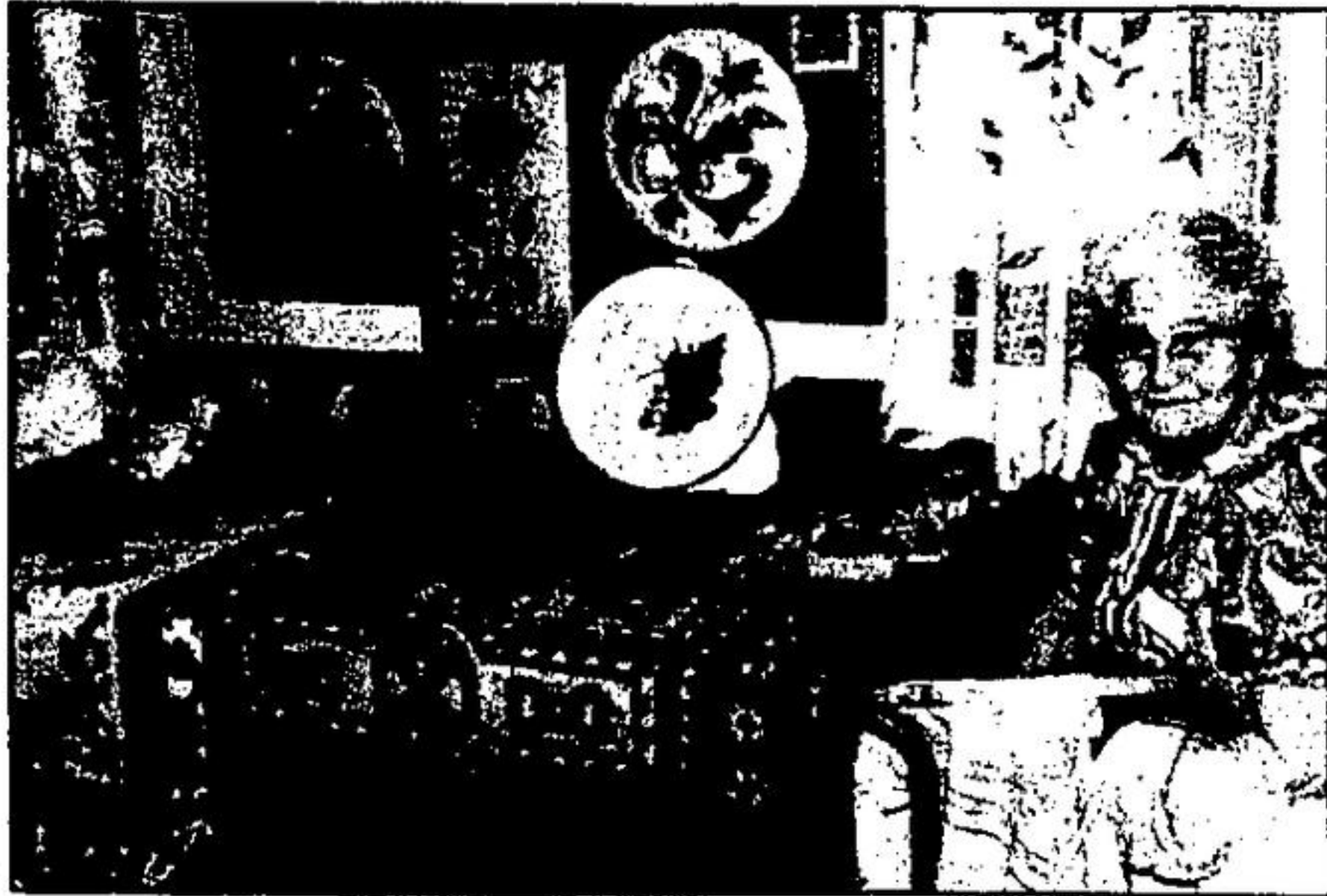


Canada Day in Limehouse

Henry Cripps, native here

A lifelong resident of Acton, Henry Irwin Cripps died suddenly at Hamilton General Hospital on Friday, June 22, in his 71st year.

Born in Acton on July 22, 1913, Henry married Hazel Tarzwell in Georgetown in 1948. She predeceased him.

He worked as a steel worker at Ajax Engineers for many years. He was a member of the Royal Canadian Legion, Branch 441, Kinmount, Ont. near his summer home.

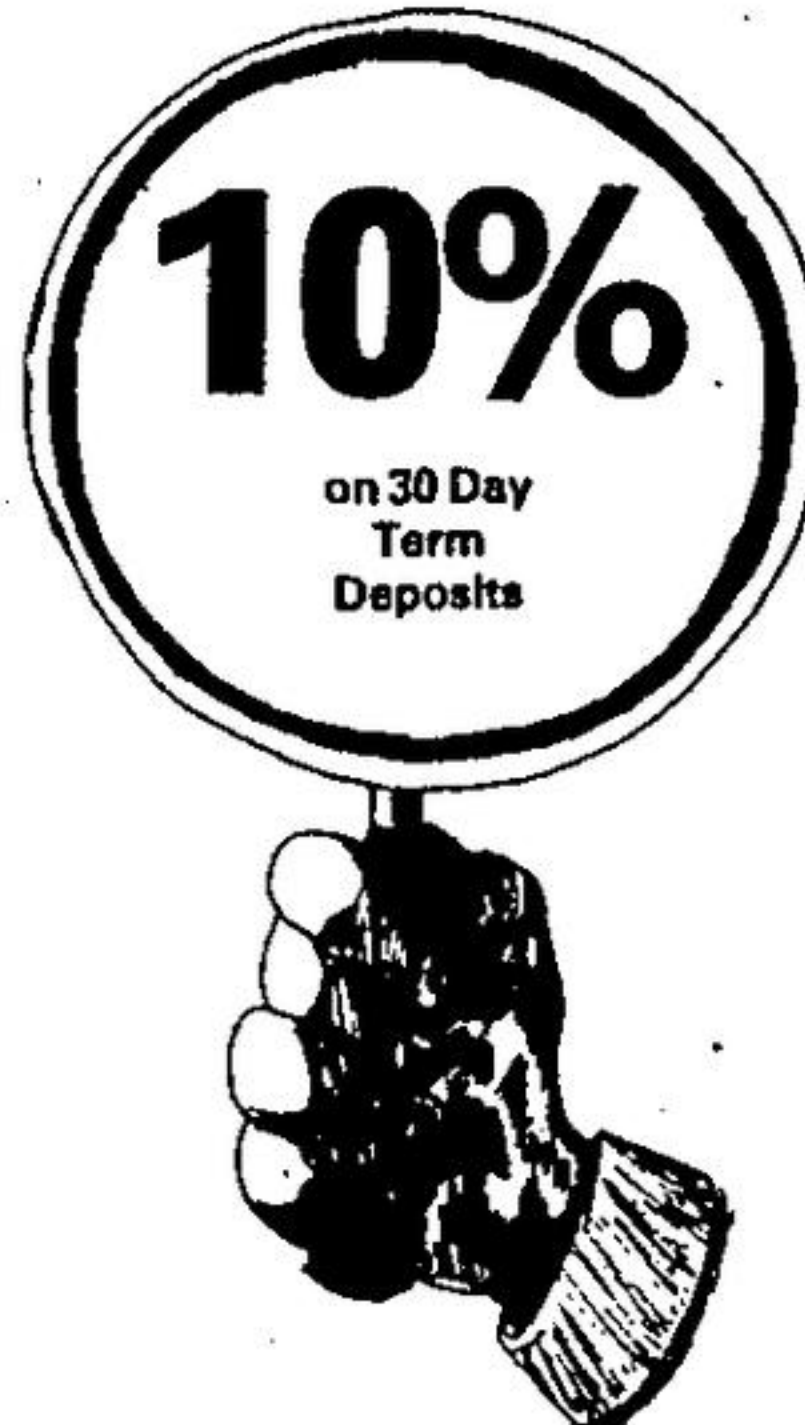

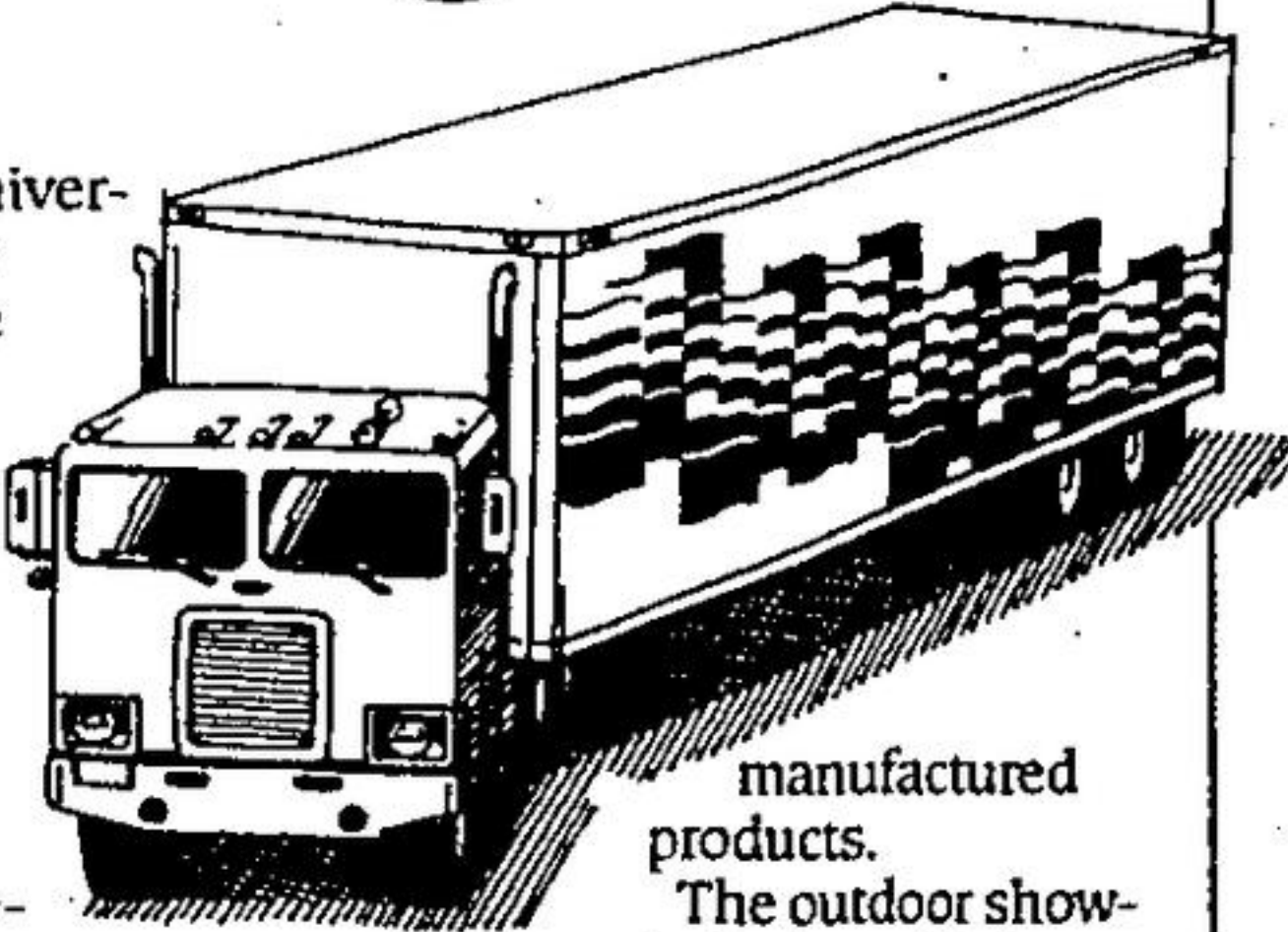

TOWN OF HALTON HILLS Fairview Cemetery Public Information Centre

The Town, in conjunction with Cosburn/Gibson Consultants Inc., is currently undertaking a review of the landscape features and a long term operational plan for Fairview Cemetery, Acton.

The review generally considers the present state of the mature spruce tree stand, the low wetlands, the northerly non-landscaped area, and the westerly wood lot.

Present proposals under consideration have a time frame of at least a further seventy years.

Public comments are invited.

A Public Information Centre is to be conducted in the Watson Room of the Acton Public Library, 17 River Street, on Thursday, July 5, 1984, from 2:30 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. Representatives of Cosburn/Gibson Consultants Inc. and Town Staff will be available for discussion.
