Plane forced down, passengers unharmed

Four Toronto-area residents escaped injury when their light plane was forced to make an emergency landing in a field near Brisbane Sunday morning.

A number of Guelph OPP and Halton regional police cruisers joined an OPP aircraft searching for the downed Cessna 172 after air traffic controllers at Pearson International Airport reported a plane was missing.

The OPP plane finally spotted the Cessna in a farmer's field near the Sixth

Line and Highway 24. Gordon Harris of Erin township is the property owner.

Guelph OPP report that the Cessna developed engine trouble en route from Toronto to Arthur, Pilot Peter Panayotis, 34, of Mississauga, managed to land the craft successfully in the field, ending up with only minor damage after it struck a fence.

Panayotis and his three passengers were not injured.


