Play for children warns of sexual abuse

Parents and teachers will be treated to an unique event this fall when the play Mission from YDOB, dealing with child sexual abuse is presented.

A Halton task force for the prevention of sexual abuse of children has prepared a proposal for the introduction of a prevention education program in Halton.

Micki Clemens, a member of the task force and presenting the proposal to the board last Thursday said sexual abuse is the most hidden and least understood of crimes and the potential for psychological damage to children is enormous.

"The prevention program is an educational program as opposed to a treatment, to teach children about it before it happens to them," she said.

The play, Mission from YDOB, (body spelled backward) was developed to teach children the different types of touching they may receive, whether it be loving or exploitive. The central character, Personnia, meets a variety of situations and people and the children in the audience are encouraged to help Personnia find solutions to the probtems and how to protect herself. In this way, children are taught to take responsibility for their bodies and feelings.

A year ago, the play was presented at Falgarwood Public School in Oakville and 200 parents, teachers, trustees, and government professionals were enthusiastic about the performance.

Trustees Dick Howitt and Arlene Bruce were among those present at the Falgarwood performance and Howitt said a person has to see the play to appreciate it properly. It is imperative, he said, that children be there to feedback to the actors so parents can evaluate its effectiveness. There were

about five or six children present at the Falgarwood play.

"The sensitivity from these children was just terrific," Bruce added.

The play, first commissioned by the Toronto Metro Chairman's Special Committee on Child Abuse formed in 1981, is designed to reach children in Grades 3 and 4, although in Toronto grades Kindergarten to 8 viewed it. The Halton task force studied the Toronto program and then prepared their three phase program. It will consist of the play, directed at only Grades 3 and 4 and a resource kit, distributed for use in the

"The play is the motivator and initiates teaching while the kit is a follow up for questions so that kids talk about their feelings," Clemens said.

The third phase consists of orientation sessions arranged for parents, teachers, and professionals in the community.

Mission from YDOB will be performed this fall in Burlington and Georgetown. Invitations will be sent to parents who will be given the option of bringing their children, to trustees, to school administrators, and to teachers of Grades 3 and 4.

After the performance, the audience will be asked to record their reactions on a twopage survey. Parents and teachers will also review the child abuse prevention kit.

In January, a report of the recommendations will be compiled and presented to the board to discuss its implementation into the Halton school system.
