**Agnes Holmes Eastern Star member**

A long-time Acton resident and member of the Eastern Star IOOE and Agricultural Society, Agnes Holmes died June 18 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Guelph after a lengthy illness. She was 80.

Born in Northern Ireland to Mary Anne and Hugh Clarke, she married Samuel Holmes, now deceased, March 8, 1921, before immigrating to this country eight years later.

The couple lived in the Ontario Communities of Forfar, Phillipville and Beachburg before moving to Acton in 1950. Sam Holmes ran a barber shop here for many years.

As well as the above-mentioned affiliations, Mrs. Holmes was a former member of the Women's Institute and attended Trinity United Church, where Rev. Don Matheson conducted her funeral service June 30 prior to interment at Fairview Cemetery.

With members of the IOOE and Eastern Star in attendance, the funeral included the singing of the 23rd Psalm by soloist Howard Weedmark.

Pallbearers were grandsons Barrie Elliott of Milton, Michael McAuley of Halifax, Samuel Holmes of Georgetown, Gregory Davidson of Almonte and John Griese and

Darcy Holmes of Guelph. Honorary pallbearers were Alfred Elliott of Kitchener and Roger Holmes of Niagara Falls.

Predeceased by husband Samuel and brothers William and Hugh Clarke of Northern Ireland, Mrs. Holmes is survived by children Mary Anne Marshall of Kitchener, Frances McAuley of Ottawa, Christina Griese of Guelph, June Davidson of Almonte, Robert of Niagara Falls and Clarke of Beaumont, Alta.

Samuel and Agnes Holmes had 18 grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild.
