## Sabres try-outs scheduled soon


With the Acton Junior B Sabres jumping back into action this week, practices and on-ice try-outs will commence within the next two weeks.

The nearest sales and warranty service for Mercury Motors is Credit River Boats situated in Norval. They also have a very impressive array of parts and boat accessories in stock.

This company has to be reached via a Brampton exchange and most motor service at this time will take up to two weeks for completion providing that parts are available.


