**RECIPE OF THE WEEK**

**FRESH FRUIT CRISP**

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Peel, core and slice 4 cups tart apples into 9" pie pan or dish, or use same amount of peaches, slightly sugared rhubarb or pitted cherries. Sprinkle with 2 tbsp. lemon juice.

Combine ½ cup all-purpose flour, ¼ cup packed brown sugar, ¼ cup butter, 1 tsp. cinnamon.

Work lightly with pastry blender. Spread over fruit in dish. Bake for about 30 minutes. Serve hot or cold with cream.
