

Antique machines Family Farm Festival

On this weekend a Family Farm Festival is being organized that will bring back the past glory of those 'lazy' days of summer... which were not very 'lazy' at all.

On the farm of Sherwood and Gladys Hume on the Fourth Line north of Steeles Ave., you will be able to see antique

tractors competing with each other to see who can turn the straightest furrow... steam tractors and threshing machines tearing sheaves of grain into straw and clean grain ready for seeding and feeding... fanning mills... a dog turning a treadmill... crafts... an old time flea market.

This year Family Farm Festival will also present a tractor pull.

On Friday and Saturday evenings there will be barn dances with steamed sweet corn fresh from the field and steamed by an ancient Sawyer-Massey steam engine. The Walters Family will provide country, western and square dance music on Saturday evening.

Seek Delay

Halton has asked Ontario's Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to either delay or reduce the Region's future repayments of Ontario Housing Action Program loans because the population of the area is significantly lower than forecast. Almost \$1,700,000 of the total \$17,221,354 in loans allocated to Halton was earmarked for water and sewer service improvements in Halton Hills.
