Progressive Conservative incumbent Otto Jelinek spent Saturday in Acton at the Military Vehicle Museum and the Railway Museum before continuing with his door-knocking campaign.

Jelinek will again be in Acton tomorrow (Thursday) "mainstreeting". Jelinek will be attending the all-candidates meeting Friday, but his campaign manager Dave White, expressed some concern about the public's participation.

"I'm concerned that the turnout might not be great," said White, because of the time of year and the day chosen for the meeting.

Liberal candidate Oriana Currie has been meeting the people of Acton through coffee parties and has found that the lack of jobs and the country's deficit are issues people want to talk to her about.

Tomorrow (Thursday) Currie will meet with Environmental Minister Charles Caccia and Brampton-Georgetown candidate Ross Milne at Halton Cable Systems in Acton at 4:30 to discuss the waste management program. Their discussion will be taped by Halton Cable.

NDP candidate Kevin Flynn was in town canvassing on Mill St. and some of the other subdivisions last Tuesday and again on Saturday. Green Party candidate Chris Kowalchuk has posted his signs in Acton on Friday. Kowalchuk is looking forward to the all-candidates meeting this Friday, he said. "People will find out who's the politician and who's giving them some alternatives," he said.
