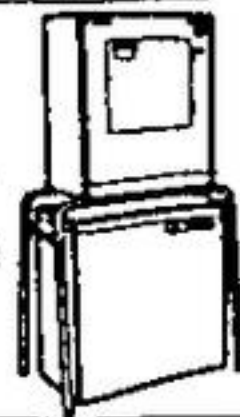

**New dance school opens**

Children, get ready to put your dancing shoes on because Tina Watling of Erin is starting her own dance school.

Watling finally decided to start her own school after setting up dance programs for YMCAs and recreation departments around Ontario since 1974.

"I love the challenge and I especially love watching the students' faces when I see they realize they can do a dance step they thought they would never be able to do. I love sharing that sort of thing," Watling said.

The Ballinacree Community Centre will be transformed into a dance studio during the evening for classes of jazz, tap, and minidance.

Jazz is the most popular form of dance in North America, she said. It is both expressive and dynamic, demanding great physical stamina and energy. Watling will accept jazz dance students, six years old and up.

Tap, she said, helps encourage a sense of rhythm using a variety of music. It requires concentration and discipline and develops good physical co-ordination. Watling accepts children five-years-old and up for her tap class.

Minidance is a fun half hour of simple dance steps, mime and music for children three and a half to five years old, Watling said. But she warns since no spectators are allowed during the class, these youngsters should be accustomed to being without their parents.

Watling said she also wants to set up a Hoofers Club for adults. It would be a fun evening of tap dancing, she said, adding that it is never too late to learn how to dance.

Watling, herself, did not start dancing until she was a young adult. She studied at the Joan Patricia School of Dance in Bolton and the Brian Foley and Jack Lemmon Studios in Toronto. Watling is associated with the British Association of Teachers of Dancing, the Canadian Dance Teachers' Association and a member of Dance in Canada Association.

But even though she is starting up her own school, Watling continues to study her art in other dance classes. A good teacher and a good dancer never stops learning, she said.

Watling said the most important aspect of dancing is teaching children to express themselves. She said some children keep a lot inside them and through dance they gain confidence to express what they are feeling.

The children will have two occasions to really express themselves. There will be a small minidance review at Christmas and a big gala show in June.

Furniture will gleam if you sprinkle on comstarch after you polish, and then rub to a high shine. Use a clean cloth to wipe up excess comstarch.

Telephones can spread cold germs, say health researchers. Keep yours germ-free and clean by wiping regularly with a paper towel dampened with alcohol.

Stubborn stains on bedspreads and sofas will respond to a mixture of one part cream of tartar, one part household cleanser, and peroxide to make a paste. Apply to the stain, let stand for 20 minutes, and rinse.

You won't have to keep opening the refrigerator all day if you give the tabs a periodic jig of juice and a supply of paper cups.
