Historical indexes now at libraries

Indexes to Acton's Early Days and nine other local historical resources have just been made available to the public by the Halton Hills Public Libraries.

Previously, historical and genealogical research in this area has meant many hours spent reading in the Local History collections of the Acton and Georgetown libraries. Now finding that information can be a matter of minutes using these indexes.

The index to Acton's Early Days, a 60 page compilation of over 8,000 references in

that comprehensive local history, has been published with the assistance of the Town of Halton Hills and the Ministry of Citizenship and Culture as one of the library's Bicentennial projects. Copies are available at both the Acton and Georgetown libraries at the cost of \$2.00.

The indexing was done by Sandra Lovegrove, a student working under the Experience '84 program of the Ontario Ministry of Citizenship and Culture. By the end of the summer she had also compiled indexes to other local histories including Georgetown, Glen Williams, Norval, and the Women's Institute histories of Halton County, Georgetown and Stewarttown (Esquesing). These indexes are available at the libraries to anyone who wishes to make copies.






