

Police blotter

Lost control

A 24-year old Churchill Rd. man received minimal injuries when he swerved to avoid an animal while driving on Hwy. 7 and lost control of his car last Wednesday night. His car which skidded into the ditch received \$2,000 damage to the front and left side. The man was charged with impaired driving and failure of a breath test.

Police responded to a domestic dispute between a husband and wife on Poplar Ave. last Thursday. The woman received some swelling to the face but no charges were laid.

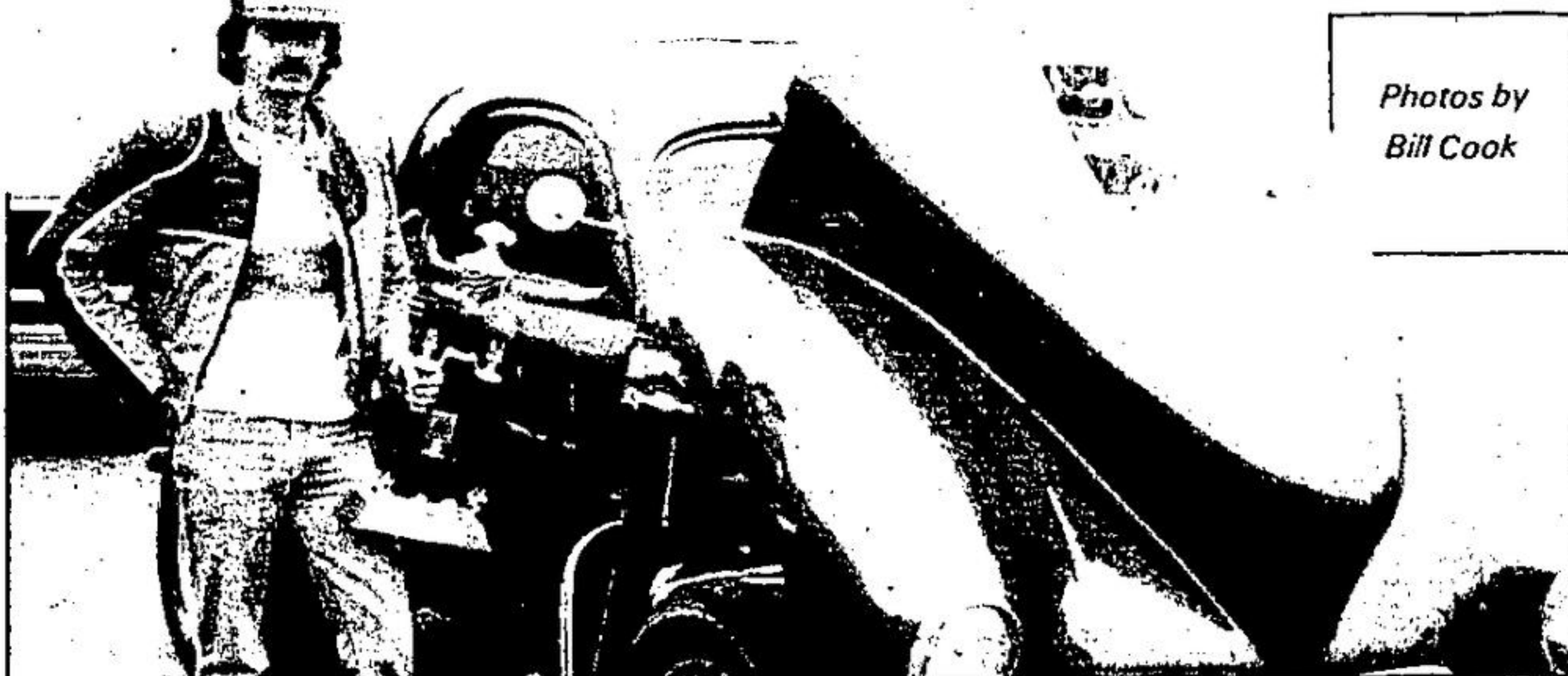
Stolen Car

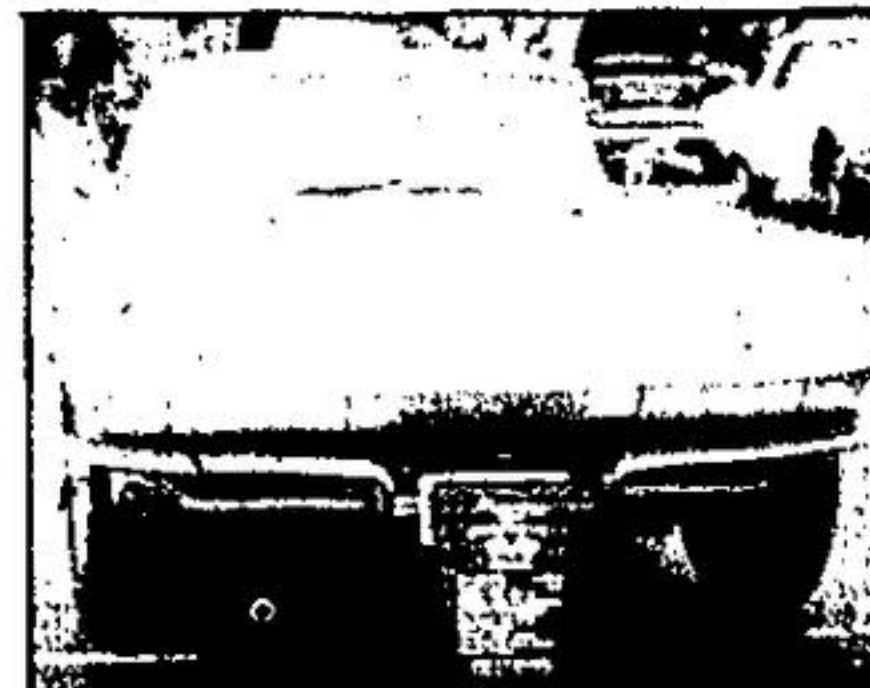
Drunk driver

Street machines come rolling in

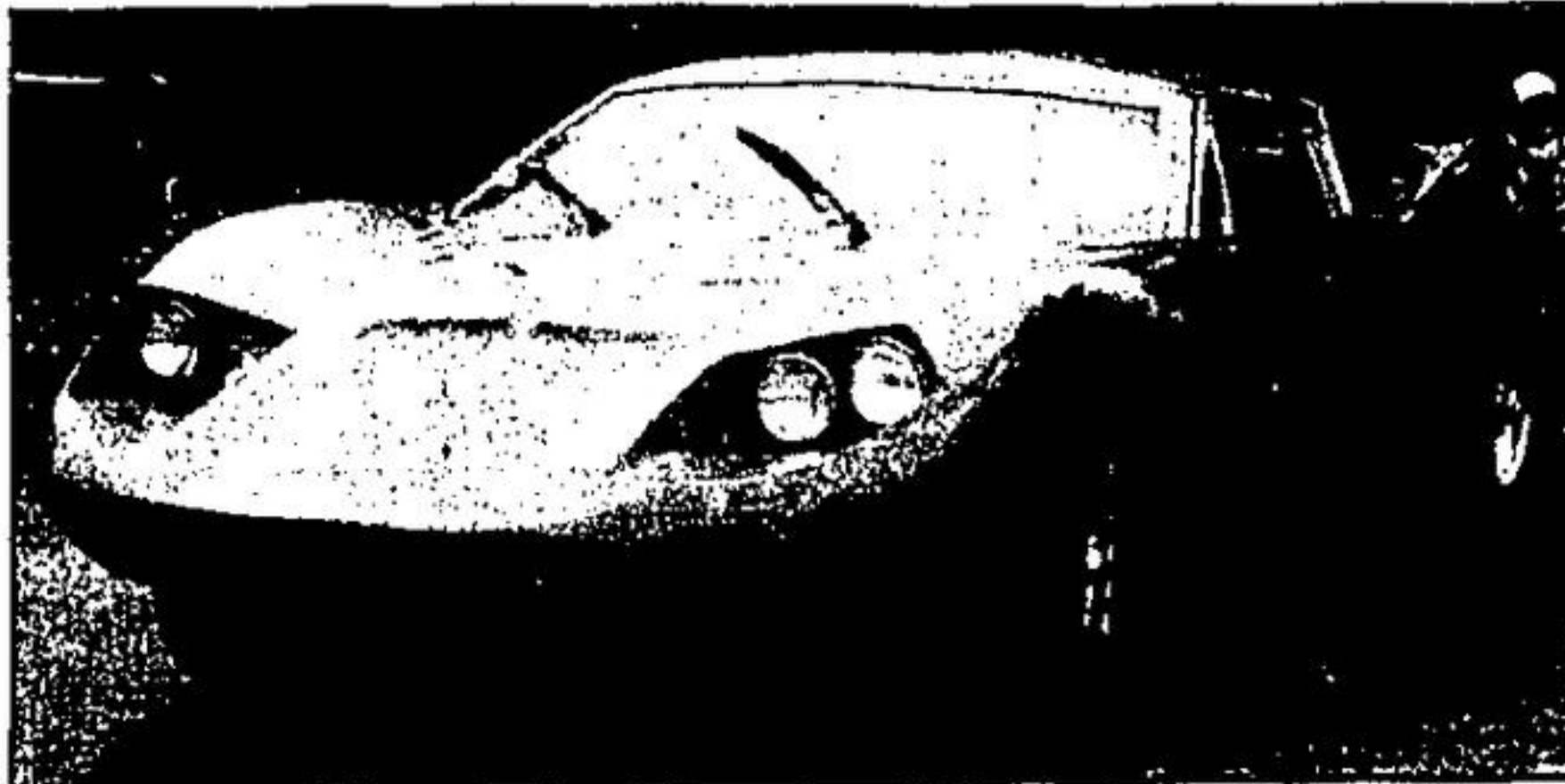


