## CREW gives public free second chance

The Co-Operative Re-Entry to Work program, better known as CREW, is looking for a new crew of students this year.

CREW has been offered at Lester B. Pearson High School in Burlington for the past five years. It helps people work towards their Grade 12 diploma and at the same time learn practical skills that will assist them in the work force, said CREW teacher, John Addi on.

Addison said in a telephone interview that the program is designed for people who cannot get a job and want to upgrade their practical skills or for people who have not been working for a number of years and want to re-enter the work force with new skills. The program also helps people who are currently working but want to get their diploma without returning to a regular classroom.

The emphasis is on the practical aspects of teaching, Addison said. The students will see for themselves the demands and expectations of a wide range of industries, he said. The students will take at least 15 field trips to different industries in the Golden Horseshoe.

CREW is fully funded by the Halton Board of Education, Addison said and there is even a free baby sitting service available.

The duration of the course is from September to May but individuals may start any time up to February 15. This is due to

the individual style of instruction, Addison said. Students work at their own pace and advance when they are ready. Addison said he really enjoys teaching this way because the students are not pressured to learn too

The subjects studied are business mathematics, business English, marketing and retailing, and sociology for the 1980s.

Classes are held in the high school's portable from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. with 11 a.m. to noon for special assistance. Remedial help is available for people with weak areas.

Addison added that CREW is flexible enough to work around the timetable of anyone who is working full-time now but want to participate in the program. Addison said he currently teaches one student on Saturday morning and another student on Wednesday evenings.

Four credits are given for the subjects taken with two more for any work experience during the year. There may be additional credits depending on the length of time out of school, he said.

Last year was CREW's most successful year with several of the participants getting good jobs or going on to community colleges, Addison said.

The class size is limited to 20 students, however, so give a call to 335-0961 and leave a message for John Addison. You will be contacted on how to join CREW.


