The Halton Hills artists, whose paintings, wall-hangings, mixed media and original prints will be exhibited at the Gallery in the

Cultural Centre October 4 to 29, includes 14 year old Roger Alchim as well as Joan Albert, Carole Black, Frank C. The jury of renowned artists, Charlotte Brainerd, Sybil Rampen and Jack Reid, also selected four artworks for awards, but the winners will not be announced until opening night October 4.

In an unusual move, the three members of the jury will be present opening night to answer questions from the public. In addition each of the judges will exhibit one piece of art work.

Admission to the opening and the month-long show is free.

Veteran actors in Blithe Spirit

A new member of the Georgetown Little Theatre could find the combined talent of Neville Worsnop and Ron Hunt awesome.

Ron Hunt has been a member of the Georgetown Little Theatre for 22 years and Neville for 11 years. Both had accumulated experience before becoming active members of the G.L.T. and have not limited themselves to the Georgetown scene. Ron was an active member of a theatrical group in Vienna for two years and has directed the Milton Players Dinner Theatre. He has often involved himself with Peel Pantomime Players and delighted thousands of children over the years with his antics in pantomime. He was a member of the original Globe Productions both as a director and on stage as Alfie Doolittle in "My Fair Lady".

Neville was a member of three theatrical groups in England before coming to Canada and is a past president of ACT and Bramalea Little Theatre. He is a founding

member of Peel Pantomime Players, a member of Bramalea Musical Society, co-founder of Dorville Theatricals and has been an active member with Harry Hansons Court Players.

The list of productions these two men have been involved with is endless, they have often worked together in the past. One production of note being "Dracula" which Neville directed and Ron handled the set design, special effects and was also stage manager. This production won a THEA in the ACT/CO Festival in 1981.

Neville Worsnop opens in the role of Charles Condomine in Noel Cowards "Blithe Spirit", directed by Ron Hunt on October 19 at the John Elliott Theatre and runs October 20, 24, 25, 26 and 27. Tickets can be ordered by telephoning the G.T. box office at 877-3700.
