New proposal to help EFW

By CARMELA FRAGOMENI A private company's proposal could be a godsend to regional officials struggling with the poor public perception and the financing of an energy-from-waste plant to burn Halton's garbage.

The company, Petro-Sun International Inc. of Brampton, has submitted a proposal to build, own, and operate its own energyfrom-waste plant to service Oakville's Union Carbide plant on Speers Road.

The \$22 million plant, which Petro-Sun calls a resource recovery plant, would not cost the region a penny, except for an \$18 per ton tipping fee to drop Halton's garbage off at the plant.

The project would be privately financed by the SNC Group, a large firm whose engineering division worked on the region's
