## Crystalline procelain graces Centre

A display of crystalline glazed porcelain now in the lobby of the Halton Hills Cultural Centre in Georgetown is arrestingly

beautiful and is catching many an eye. It is the work of potter Grace McKnight, who owns and operates Charis Pottery in Glen Williams.

It is rated highly enough in the art world to have been chosen to be shown in the Richmond Art Gallery in Richmond B.C.

pottery. Specially formulated glazes are fired at exceedingly high temperatures, and a regulated cooling period causes the highly fluid glaze to "freeze" forming beautiful crystals. Like snowflakes no two crystalline pieces are alike.

Her fascination with snowflakes and frost patterns on glass since childhood helpedspark her interest in attaining this effect on porcelain.

For the seventh consecutive year Grace will hold what she calls a "Fall Happening" at Charis Pottery in the Glen. On two weekends, November 17 and 18 and November 24 and 25, she invites children to create a pot of their own, while the adults browse through her studio and enjoy hot

mulled cider and cookies.

In addition to the crystalline glazed porcelain all types of finely crafted pottery formed on the wheel and fired right there in her studio, are produced by the artist.

Largely self taught, but starting in the Kingston Potter Guild in 1978, Grace opened her own spot in the Glen in 1978, naming it Charis since that is the Greek word for grace.

Her work may also be seen in galleries in Toronto, Muskoka and Vancouver.

The graceful arrangement of her crystalline glazed porcelain in the Cultural Centre, she attributes to her friend Alissa Finnis, who is a professional window dresser.




