Approve projects on Credit River

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority has received approval from the Ministry of Natural Resources, to undertake preventative erosion control works at five sites along the Credit River and Applewood Creek within the Regional Municipalities of Halton and Peel.

At these particular locations, existing buildings and commercial facilities are being threatened by a variety of slope stability and severe bank erosion problems. Installations of gabions, riprap, slope drainage improvements and revegetation are the proposed erosion protection measures. Installation of erosion control measures will prevent major capital works projects in the future, the Authority explains.

The Authority has completed over eight erosion control projects this year.






