RECIPE OF THE WEEK
FRUIT FINGERS

125 mL honey	1/2 cup
75 mL shortening	1/2 cup
250 mL boiling water	1 cup
500 mL raisins	2 cups
10 mL cinnamon	2 tsp.
2 mL nutmeg	1/2 tsp.
5 mL salt	1 tsp.
5 mL baking soda	1 tsp.
10 mL water	2 tsp.
500 mL flour	2 cups
5 mL baking powder	1 tsp.
125 mL chopped walnuts	1/2 cup
125 mL chopped glace cherries	1/2 cup

Place the first six ingredients in a large saucepan and boil gently for 3 min.; cool. Dissolve the salt and baking soda in the 10 mL (2 tsp.) water and add to the boiled mixture. Sift flour and baking powder three times and add to the boiled ingredients, mixing thoroughly. Pour half the batter into a greased 2 L (12 x 8 x 2 in.) cake pan; sprinkle with nuts and cherries; cover with remaining batter. Bake at 160°C (325°F) for 50-60 min. Cut into fingers when cool. (ONE 2 L (12 x 8 x 2 in.) CAKE)
