TURKEY OR CHICKEN CASSEROLE WITH **VEGETABLES**

Melt 3 thsp, butter. Stir in and saute gently until lightly browned:

14 cup diced celery

15 cup thinly alliced onion 14 cup thinly sliced green pepper

Sprinkle over top and cook slowly for 5 minutes: 3 thsp. flour

Stir in gradually 1% cups turkey or chicken stock. Remove from heat. Stir In 2 lightly beaten egg yolks, salt and pepper to taste, and add 2 cups cubed turkey or chicken. Stir over low heat just long enough to thicken sauce slightly. You may add 3 thap. white wine. Place in cesserole. Sprinkle with minced chives or parsley, or cheese.




