PILOTS MAY INTERCEDE WANT AIRPORT REMAIN

Thirty-five people, most of them pilots, rallied at Rosslake R. R. 3, Georgetown Monday night in an effort to bring about a reversal of the Department of Transport's order to close the landing strip there by March 1.

They hope by waging a letter campaign to convince the D.O.T. the closure order was unwarranted.

SETS PRECEDENT

Rosslake owner Joe Ross said it is possible the Canadian Owners and Pilots' Association will intercede. COPA claims the closure sets a precedent which could affect other private airstrips all across the country.

About eight planes use the airstrip and tie-down facilities on a regular basis. The pilots are almost all local, most of them Air Canada men who have their own aircraft.

What happens to the landing strip if the closure sticks? "I may turn it into a drag strip," the owner was quoted as saying. "The track is already there."

TAKE NOTICE

Township of Esquising
BY-LAW NO. 21-67

A By-law prohibiting the running at large of dogs in the Hamlet of Glen Williams.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to prohibit the running at large of dogs in the Hamlet of Glen Williams;

AND WHEREAS the power to prohibit the running at large of dogs in a defined area of the Municipality is conveyed on the Councils of Townships, towns, villages and cities with a population of less than 100,000 by Subsection 1 of Section 6 of Dog Tax and Livestock Protection Act, Chapter 111, RSO 1930 and amendments thereto;

Now Therefore The Council of The Corporation of Esquising Enacts as follows:

1. From and after the passing of this by-law, no dog or dogs shall be permitted to run at large in the Hamlet of Glen Williams as defined in By-law No. 20-67.

2. Any dog found running at large in Glen Williams and not under proper control may be impounded and, if not claimed by the owner within one week, may be destroyed.

3. The owner of a dog so impounded shall be liable for all expenses incurred by the Dog Control Officer in impounding the dog, and in the case of a second or subsequent offence may be fined in an amount of not less than \$10 or more than \$25.

4. This By-law shall apply to all of the Hamlet of Glen Williams as set out in By-law No. 20-67 except for bona-fide farms of 20 acres or more, which farms shall be exempted from the provisions of this By-law.

Read a first, second and third time and passed this first day of August, 1967.

All proposed trench excavations on Municipal or private property in the Town of Georgetown must be reported by the constructor in writing to the Inspector appointed by Council to ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THE TRENCH EXCAVATORS' PROTECTION ACT PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF EXCAVATION.

Exceptions: 1. Trenches less than 4 feet in depth or where the width is greater than the depth.

2. Where no person will enter the trench except the owner of the property.
