Snow said the fund will ease the tight money situation for home buyers.

The fund will finance first and second mortgages to purchasers of new homes, with interest rates similar to those charged by the federal Central Mortgage and Housing Corp.

The fund Snow said will be operated by the Ontario Housing Corp. Terms will be for a maximum loan of 95 per cent of the lending value of the dwelling with repayment up to 35 years.

"This (fund) is a considerab. le amount of money to spend, but it will make it easier to make homes available," Snow said "Previously, builders had, the plans, equipment and men to begin construction, but no money."

Snow feels the \$100 a year; prepared by two teenage property tax rebate for old age pensioners will be of considerable help to most elderly people who are living on fixed incomes and find tax boosts. hard to cope with.
