

Served County for Fifty Years Former Registrar Dies

Miss Myrtle B. Field, for many years Registrar of Deeds in the Halton County Registry Office died in Halton Centennial Manor on May 17.

She was the daughter of the late James and Mary Elizabeth Field of Milton and sister of Roy of Milton.

Miss Field was well known as an adept registrar of deeds and she knew every plot of land in Halton County. Born and educated in Milton, she started working at the Registry Office during her high school years by going in after school to help the registrar do copy work. After she left school she went to work there full time and in 1902 she was named Deputy Registrar. She served under four registrars before she was named Registrar in the early 30's. In 1939 she served as treasurer of the Ontario Registrars' Association.
