## Grades One, Two Will Get Measles Vaccine

Nearly 10,000 children in the high incidence of German measles but said there is no epidemic and none is anticipated the next two years.

Dr. J. H. Chamberlain, Halton medical officer of health and director of the county health unit, said last week "The policy is to deal with children in the early school years."

### WHAT ACTION

Dr. Chamberlain was replying to a question as to what action the unit planned to take in response to the high incidence of German measles recently.

The baby doctors' organization, the Canadian Pediatrics Society, passed a resolution Monday at its Winnipeg convention urging all levels of government to institute mass vaccination against a looming measles epidemic.

### UNBORN CHILDREN

Dr. Donald McLean, chairman of the society's infectious diseases committee said health authorities are not taking advantage of the vaccine despite the danger posed to unborn children.

Dr. Chamberlain said that 100,000 children in grades one and two will be vaccinated this year and all those in grades one to four next year.
