The growing trend towards faraway field trips for student groups may cause social and economic class splits within the schools several Roman Catholic trustees cautioned last week at a meeting of the Halton Roman Catholic School Board.

The cost of the trips is becoming so great, they said, it may become a mark of status who can afford to go and who has to stay home.

Superintendent J. D. Hogan said the practice of taking (faraway) field trips is increasing — they may be going to Europe soon.

The board was reminded that an Acton high school student group is going on a field trip to the Mediterranean for 18 days. Minimum cost per student: \$405.

Hogan said the idea for the St. Michael's trip "originated with the bus company" that sent around a brochure.

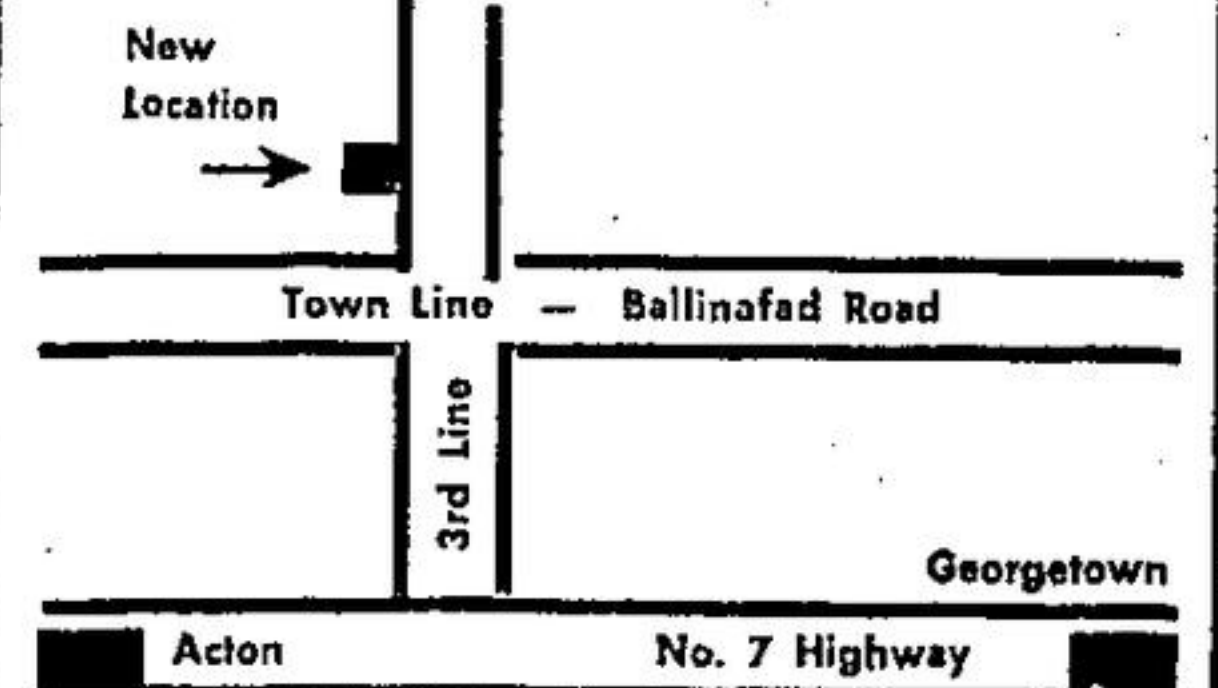
