3) The Journal American Metical Ass'n Feb. 18, 1961 edition related that fluorine is stored in considerable quantity in the soft tissues, as in the aorta, kidneys, skin and eyes.

4) The Dental Digest, April 1964, Page 170-172 edition indicated that in twelve separate studies on twenty eight groups of mice, at the University of Yexas, fluoridated water reduced the life span of the mice about nine percent. Similar tests showed findings of fluoride harm on rats at Cornell University as reported in the Journal of Gerontology Jan, 1957 Page 14 publication.

5) Since fluoridation began, national figures on Mongolism are increasing atarmingly, and Medical Times, Feb. 1963 Page 114 has noted a significant trend toward increasing Mongolism in fluoridated Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

6) Statement of fluoridation, American House of Delegates, Dec. 1967, Page 13 stated that the probability is twenty-one to one that fluorine caused deaths in Bartlett, Texas.

7) Dr. A. L. Russell in the Journal American Dental Ass'n. Nov. 1962, page 610, studies made showed that 40.2% of begroe children in Grand Rapids, Mich. develop dental fluorosis and 19.3% of white childen are affected.

8) It is impossible to guarantee that all people will receive one part fluorine per million of water which is the maximum. Control of fluoride intake into human body is impossible by means of fluoridated water.

When sodium fluoride is obtained by prescription, one is warned not to take more than one Mg.

9) Sodium fluoride is listed in the American and British Pharmacopoeias as a poison. It is used in biochemistry as an enzyme inhibitor.

10) Calling fluorine a powerful enzyme poison, scientists noted that rabbits were blinded when given fluorides. It is sigmilicant that in both 1913 and 1953 studies, excessive catarracts were found in naturally fluoridated Bartlett, Texas.




