

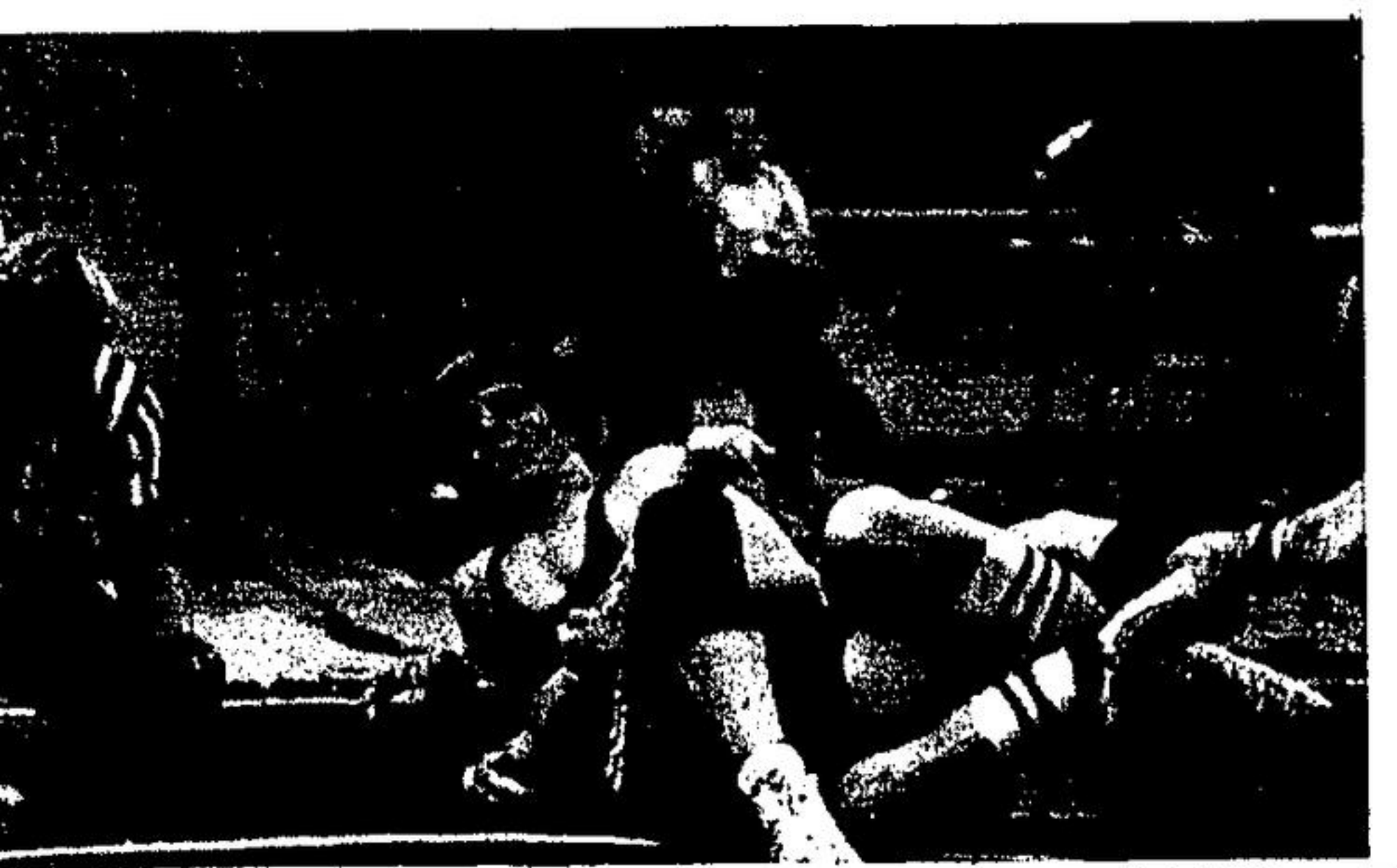
# Capture Six Firsts, Win Area Wrestling
