LET'S PLAY BRIDGE

BRIDGE CLUB

An "end play" is not something that happens only in football. An end play at bridge is a play whereby an opponent is placed on lead and must concede a trick or several tricks by his next lead. Here is a rather dramatic example where declarer end played an opponent in order to make a slam contract.

South dealt with neither side vulnerable.

Opening lead: Nine of hearts.

South hopes to find no more than three minor suit cards in North's hand. If there are two diamonds and a club, declarer has no problem. With the actual holding, declarer can set up a club trick in order to discard dummy's diamond but the defence will cash a diamond first.

FINISHED DEFENCE

Several defenders led the diamond ace and this finished the defence. Declarer discarded a club on the diamond king and ruffed out his losers. Where the defence got off to a neutral lead, declarer needed to keep his wits about him. Declarer should first try to set up the heart suit.

The opening lead is won in dummy and dummy's king of spades takes out the opponent's trump. The second high heart allows declarer to discard one club. A low heart is led and ruffed. When West shows out, declarer is in trouble.

West is marked with the diamond ace and the club king for all his bidding. How can declarer avoid two losers?

SOLVED PROBLEMS

One declarer solved the problem as follows. Dummy was entered with a trump and the diamond seven was played. When East played low, declarer played the ten. West won but was end played. If he played the diamond ace, declarer could ruff and later discard a club on the diamond king. If West led a low diamond declarer could discard a club and win with the king. East actually led a club hoping that his partner had the queen. However, declarer held that card and the slam was made.

NO GOOD

It does East no good to play the diamond jack on the lead from dummy. Declarer could cover with the king and reach the same position all because he held the diamond ten.
