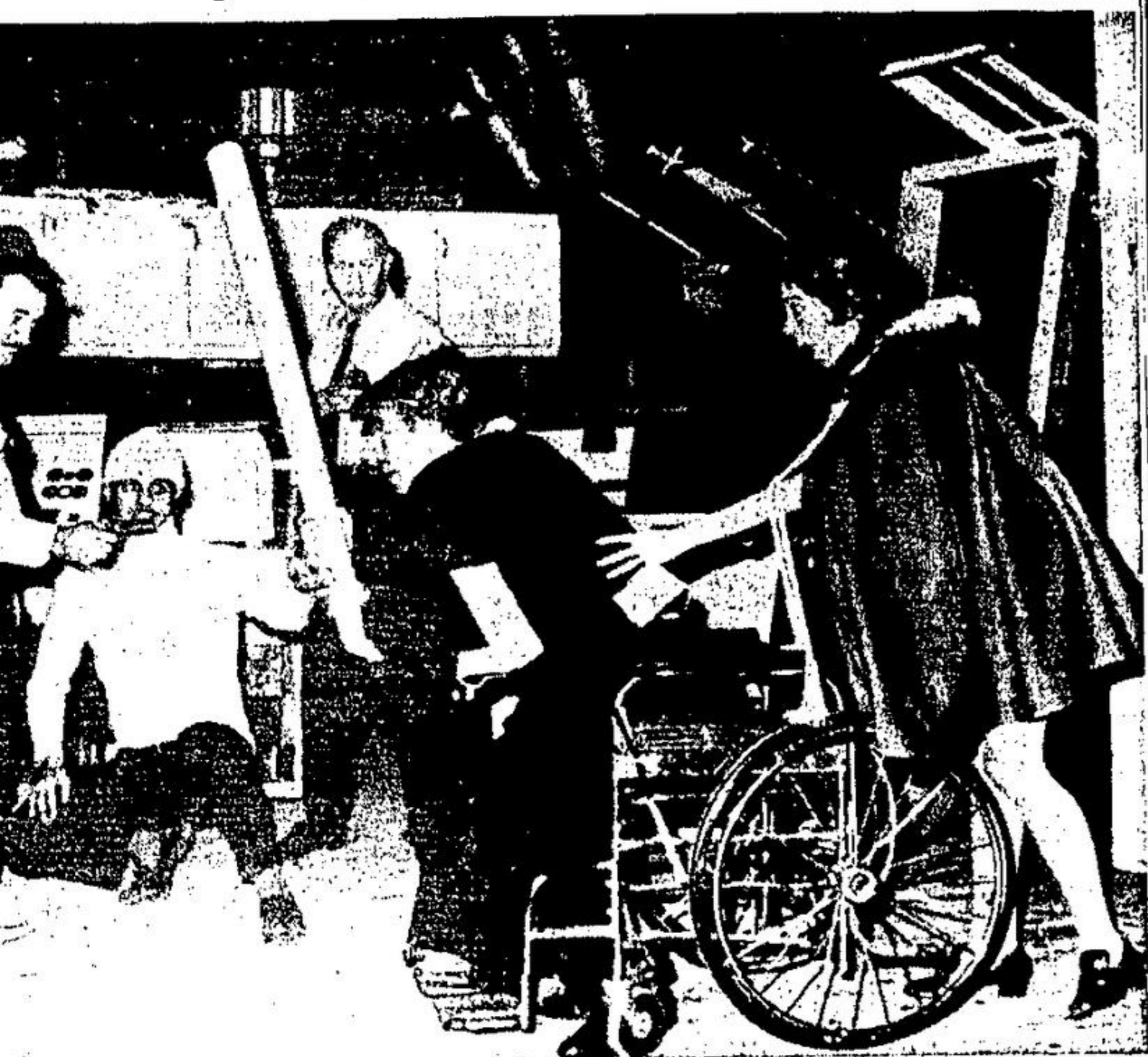


Professor (Yea) a Threat Greedy Popcorn King (Boo)
