"Don't be fooled by some of the things you read in the papers about the effects of soft drugs," Judge R. J. Graham told two youths in Halton County court this week.

"In the past seven years I have seen a good many who strayed just as you did," he continued.

"They are now in penitentiaries for serious crimes, confirmed drug addicts. This disproves for me the theory that there is no harm in marijuana."

The youths both Oakville high school students, were arrested November 20.

Fathers of both boys appeared in court with them and told Judge Graham their sons had otherwise never caused trouble.

Judge Graham assessed each boy a fine of \$150 or 30 days in jail.

### Almost 800 Volunteers Helping Halton Schools

A total of 797 volunteers are giving nearly 2,000 hours of time working in Halton schools. Their selective subjects, such as photography, shop and other of time working in Halton schools.
