

# 100 Left Sheridan In Term

OAKVILLE — Of the 1,860 persons who registered at Sheridan College's three campuses in September, a total of 100 have withdrawn from the college up to the present date.

Miss Elizabeth Banister, assistant registrar at the college, said this morning that there could be several different reasons that these students dropped out, ranging from illness to financial reasons to personal reasons they would not disclose.

Ms. Banister said none had been forced to leave since the college does not have an arbitrary grade at which they ask students to leave.

Although results from first term exams, which finished Jan. 15 are only coming out, Ms. Banister said that these would have no effect in the students' leaving the college. She said, "If a student fails in his exams he is still credited on a total grade point average."

Ms. Banister also said that some of the students who dropped out "may be non-registered."

She did not consider 100 students a high drop-out rate since it was only 8.6 per cent of the total population. "There is nothing wrong with the admission standards," she said.

# Talks Opened First In Weeks

BRAMPTON — An intensification of effort by all parties involved in the nine-week-old Consumers' Gas Company strike could lead to a settlement in the near future.

Company and union met for the first time in weeks Sunday at the instigation of the department of labor. No reports are available of what took place at that meeting.

Area Superintendent Norm Quinn of Consumers' is meeting today with other company officials and speculation has been voiced that the meeting may be to change some aspect of the company's stand. Union negotiators are said to be doing the same thing.

Company president O. A. H. Jones is meeting today with Toronto Mayor William Dennison and his committee in hopes of setting a dialogue going that will result in a tentative settlement or at least a better understanding between the parties.

District Manager Eugene McNamara told The Daily Times today that nothing has been settled yet or really changed at all but that the future looks a little better and a settlement could be within reach.

He said the company and the unions were slated to meet again tomorrow for further negotiations.

# Milk Store Theft Of \$970 Reported

MISSISSAUGA — A Mae's Milk store at the Applewood Hills plaza was robbed Saturday night by two youth identified as being in their late teens, police said this morning. Police said the two left with a total of \$970.

One man first posed as if he were buying cigarettes, police said. When all was clear in the store, the other entered and the manager and a customer were forced to the back of the store. Both men were armed with small calibre pistols.

Police described one as having a dark complexion with shoulder-length black hair, wearing a three-quarter-length light brown coat at the time of the hold-up. The other was described as having light golden hair.

Police are still investigating the incident.

Brampton police officer told the court he had followed the youth with a motorcycle to his home where he stopped from the bike and dismounted.
