

# Kerr Orders Study Into Halton's Roadside Spray

Energy and Resources minister George Kerr of Burlington announced this week he has ordered a top-level study into the use of the weedkiller 2,4,5-T along Halton County roadsides.

Kerr said the study will involve the departments of Health, Agriculture and Energy and Resources as well as the Deputy Ministers Council on the Environment.

Kerr said he ordered the study after receiving a letter from the Halton County Environmental Protective Association which complained about the use of 2,4,5-T for roadside spraying.

The action was taken after Niagara Brand Chemicals of Burlington advised that Dr. Clay Switzer of the Botany department and Dr. Gerry Stephenson of the crops science department were prepared to come and support the use of the chemicals.

"If someone is coming to tell us one side of the story, we should get the other side as well," Warden F. G. Oakes said in supporting the invitation to the two professors.

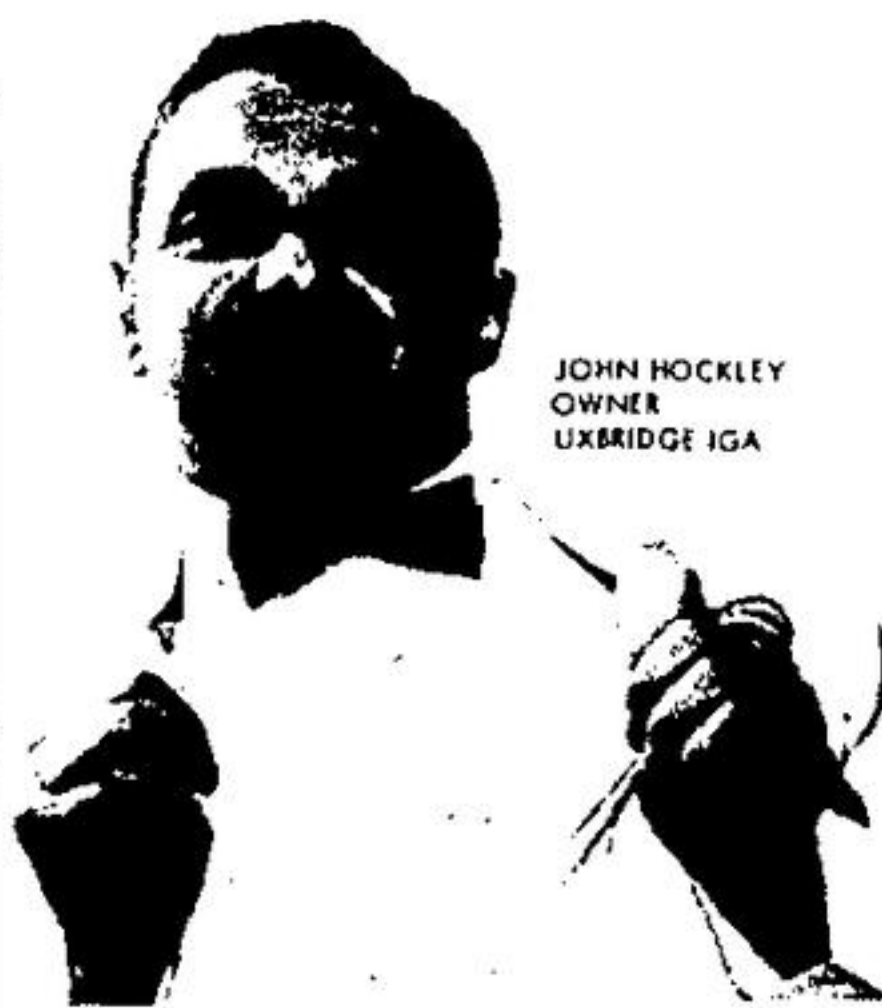
