Community Service Aim of Witnesses' Guelph Seminar

Eighty persons from the Georgetown area have indicated they will be journeying to Guelph this Friday to attend a three day seminar in community service sponsored by Jehovah's Witnesses. Nearly 1,000 witnesses from nearby congregations will meet in the Guelph Collegiate Institute, March 19, 20 and 21.

The event is to place emphasis on the delegates serving the spiritual needs of others in their home communities. Final make-up of the delegation was announced by the presiding minister, Mel Taylor, at the Kingdom Hall this week.

**NO MORTALITY BASIS**  
Explaining the emphasis placed on spiritual counselling Mr. Taylor pointed out the current challenges to Christian faith, and to the mental and emotional insecurity of our fast-changing world. He cited a greater need for personal spiritual assistance, less formal and more specific than the traditional Sunday service.

Mr. Taylor stated, "Young persons are being confronted with a total materialistic outlook by today's educators. Evolutionary concepts of life, as opposed to the absolute creation concept of the Bible, leave these young people absolutely no basis for morality, or even common honesty."

**IN 32 HOMES**  
"Our answer to this challenge," he stated, "is home Bible instruction, offered free of charge, without obligation, to persons of any conviction."

"The training program this weekend in Guelph will concentrate on the starting and conducting this program in 32 homes", Mr. Taylor then asserted, "These private studies have already equipped many thousands with a knowledge of the Bible and an appreciation of its principles."

"While this may not produce the material benefits of some community services, it has produced persons of strong moral fibre and firm convictions, persons with a goal in life. It produces industrious and principled adults, with a reverence for life and its source. This is what Christianity was all about and still is," he said.
