

12 Miles for 21 in County's Road Swap

After two year's planning and study the Halton Roads Needs Study was approved by county council last week and is ready for implementation. It means a network of roads which may form the nucleus of a regional streets and roads system. The report — to be implemented over the next 10 years — calls for the county to take over 21 miles of roads now under jurisdiction of municipalities. In turn the municipalities will receive 12 miles of roads back from the county.

With 162 miles of roads and 45 bridges in the county system, this means the county would eventually assume responsibility for 183 miles of roads.

THE STUDY

Duncan Hopper and Associates Ltd. of Weston was hired by the county to draw up the study and worked in co-operation with the county roads department and council roads committee.

Although the report calls for work to be spaced over the next 10 years, it concentrates on work to be done now and by 1978. It will cost \$10,885,300 to implement some of its recommendations in the next five years. Roughly one-fifth of the money will be spent each year.

This year the costs will be \$2,058,000 and just under half of this will come from the seven municipalities.

The remainder will be paid by Ontario Department of Highways.

Bump on Head Is Only Injury After Car Rolls

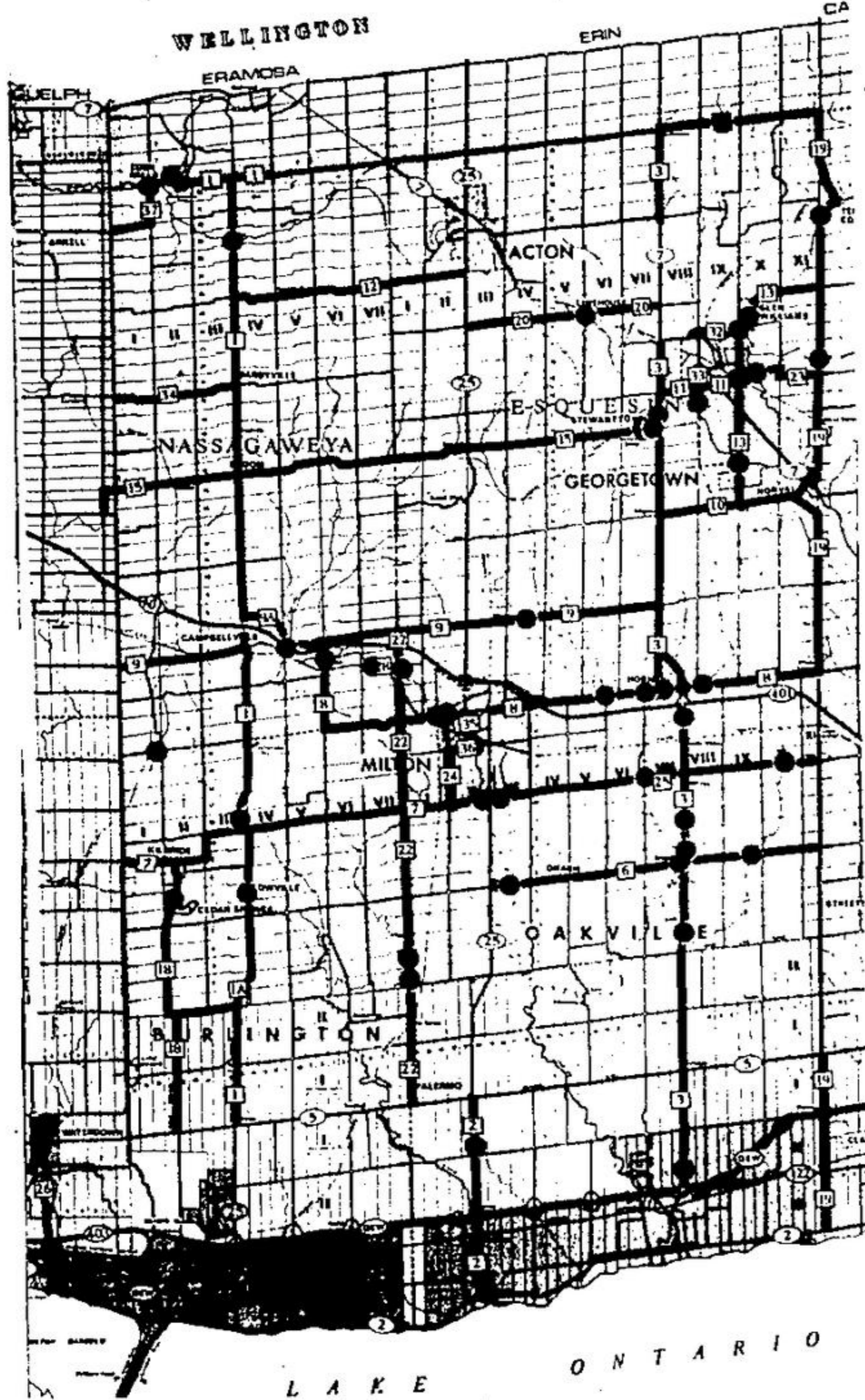

Another single car accident, on March 19th, saw \$150 damage done to the '69 Ford driven by John M. Stevens, 11 Heather Court, Georgetown. The scene was the 7th line, north of the Base Line.

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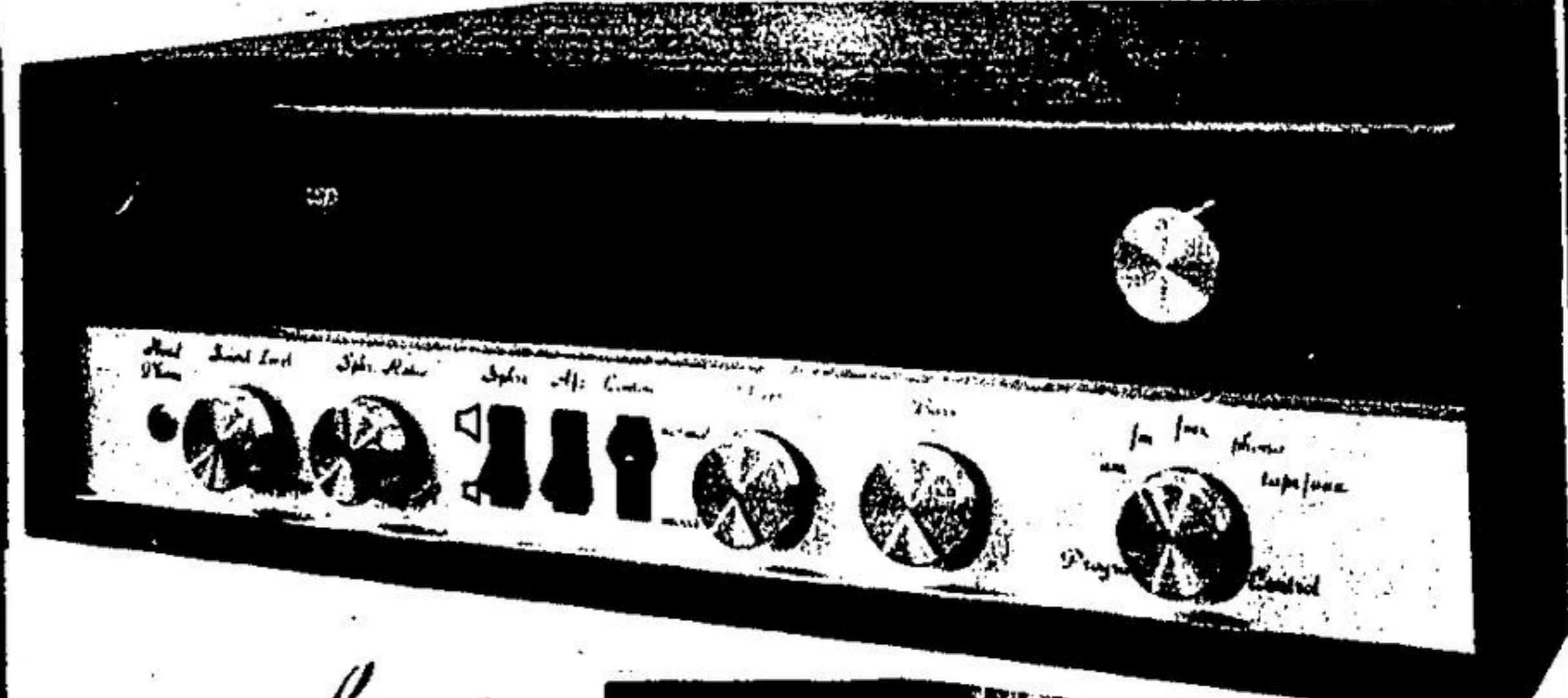
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
