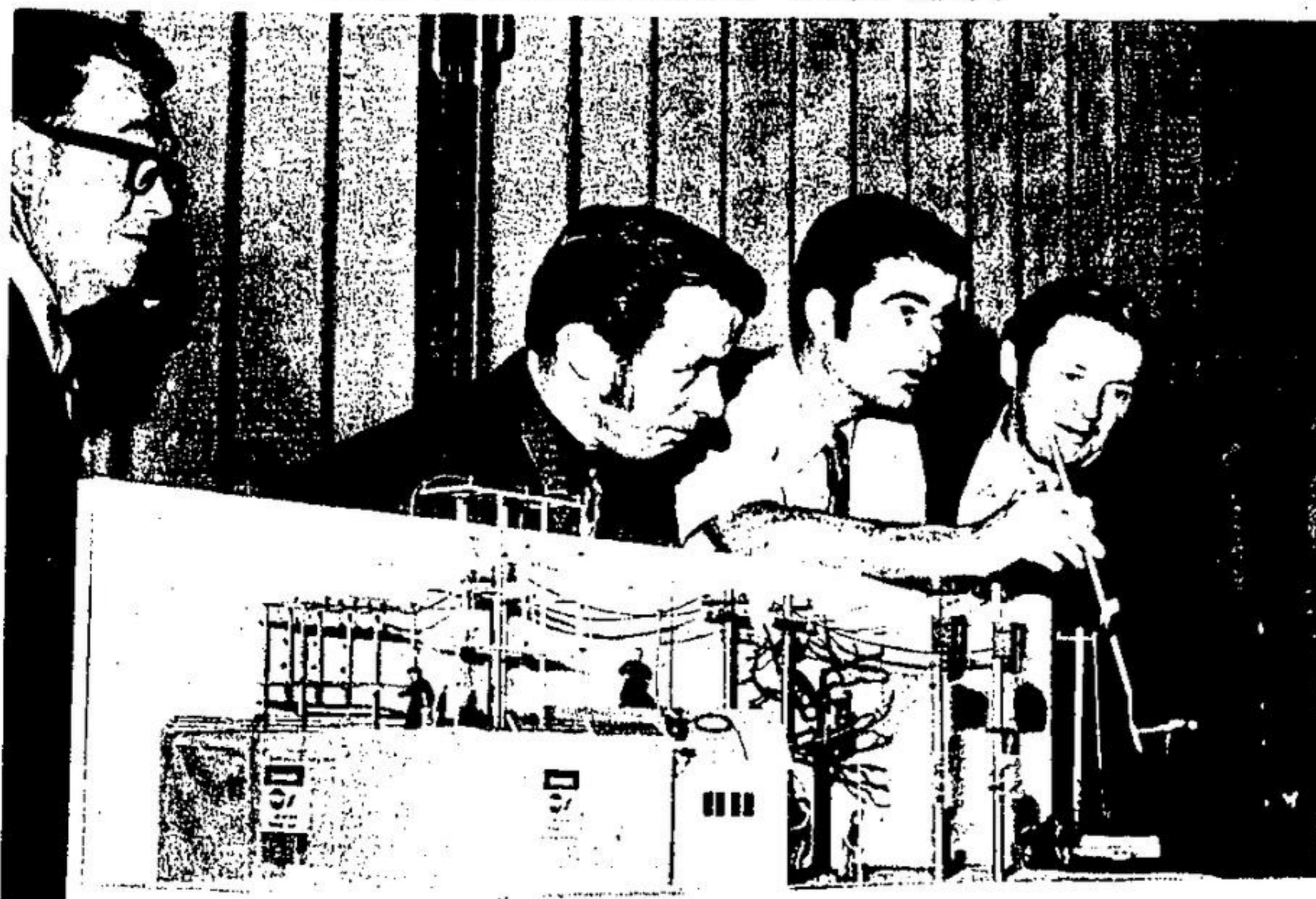


ONE SHOCKING DISPLAY
