



TRY PINEAPPLE - LEMON CRUNCH PUDDING

Ingredients:
 1/2 cup Grape-Nuts Brand Cereal
 1/4 cup firmly packed brown sugar
 2 tablespoons melted butter
 1 envelope (4 oz.) lemon pie filling
 1/2 cup drained crushed pineapple
 1 envelope dessert topping mix
 Combine cereal, sugar and butter. Set aside.
 Prepare pie filling, mix as directed on package. Cool pie filling completely. Stir in pineapple. Reserving a small amount of cereal mixture for garnish, alternately spoon pie filling and cereal mixture into serving dish or parfait glasses, starting and ending with pie filling. Chill.
 Prepare dessert topping mix as directed on package. Garnish with whipped topping and sprinkle with reserved cereal mixture. Makes 6 to 8 servings.
