It will cost more than \$4,360 a day to take 9,200 Halton County students to school by bus when classes begin next week.

Halton education officials said 6,100 public school students will travel 5,231 miles a day on 154 bus routes at a cost of \$2,693. More than 3,000 secondary

students will cover 3,647 miles on 66 routes and run up a daily tab of \$1,676 for Halton taxpayers. Special taxis and buses will

cost \$346 a day to transport bandicapped and orthopedic students to school. There are 46,000 public and secondary students in Halton
