## Georgetown Based Service Offers Family Counselling

One of the least known but important free services available to people in North Halton carries the title of Family and Social Counselling Unit.

There's an office Georgetown, downstairs at 130 Guelph St. where the Health Unit's located. It is open Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. There's another in the county building at Milton on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

They are staffed by Mrs. Aina Dzidrums, an attractive family counsellor willing to give assistance to anyone from the north end of the county.

Mrs. Dzidrums says referrals are accepted from private individuals, doctors, lawyers, the court, public health people, schools, police, any responsible people or just a request from a person in trouble.


WINNER IN NEW YORK
