**Four People Killed in Two Area Crashes**

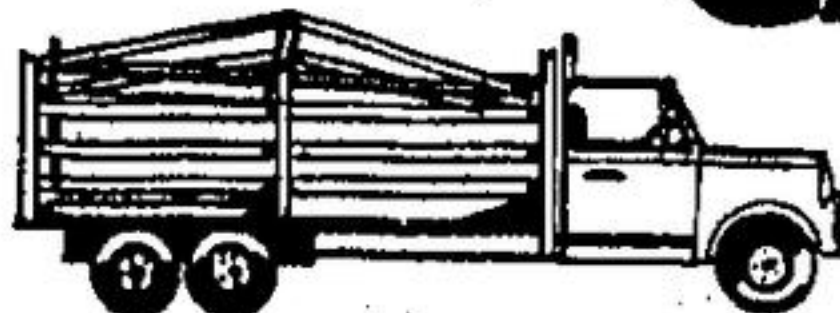
Three men died in the head on crash of two cars on Highway 24 one mile southwest of Erin just minutes past Saturday midnight. Dead are George Allan Tilcox, 19, of Hillburgh, his passenger, Raymond D. Thompson, 19, of Moxton, Ontario, and the driver of the second car Bernard V. Cassar, 34, of Orangeville. All three were pronounced dead at the scene. Both vehicles, which were

completely destroyed, were small cars. A single car crash near Campbellville Saturday night claimed the life of an Oakville man and injured two passengers. **THROWN OUT** Dead is Robert D. Lohrin. He was thrown 60 feet after his car hit a median sign and rolled over at the Campbellville Road overpass. Ross Armstrong, 24, Toronto, was also hurled from

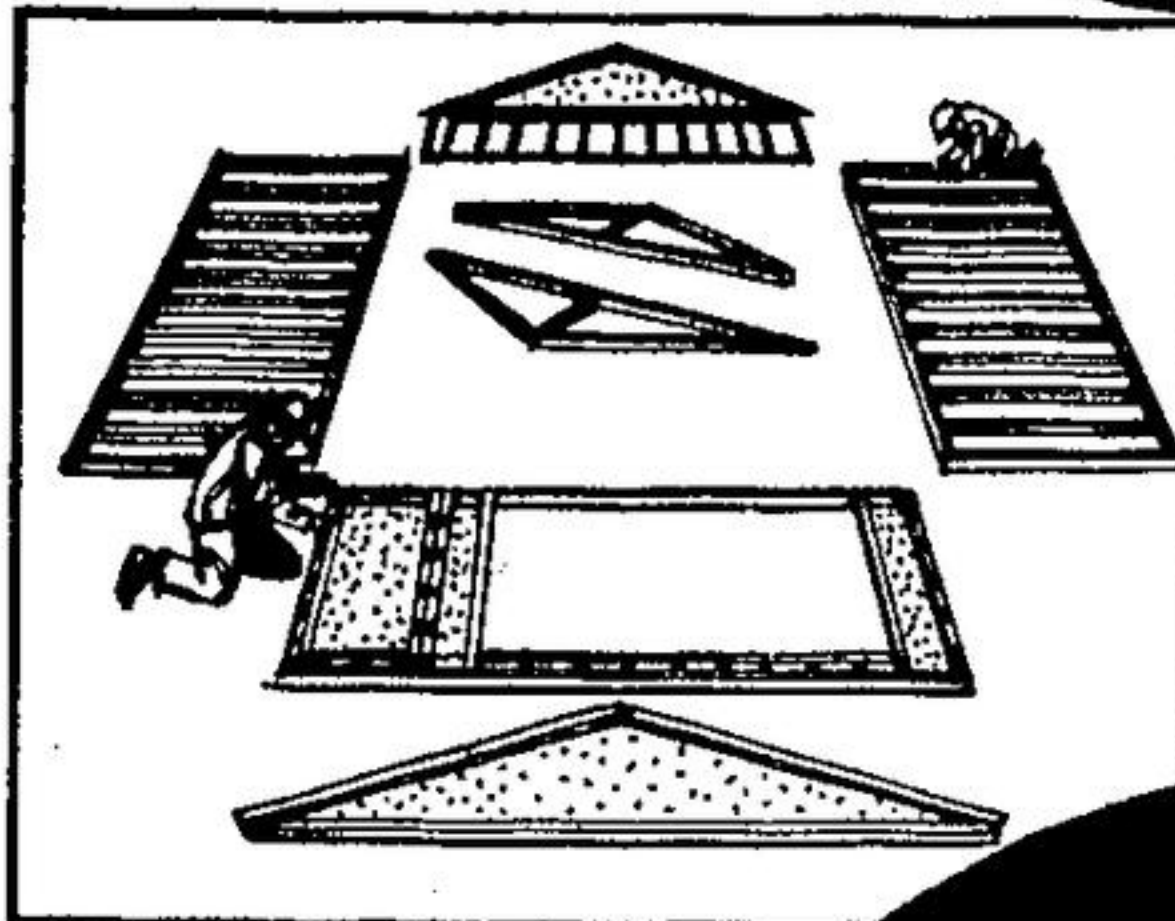
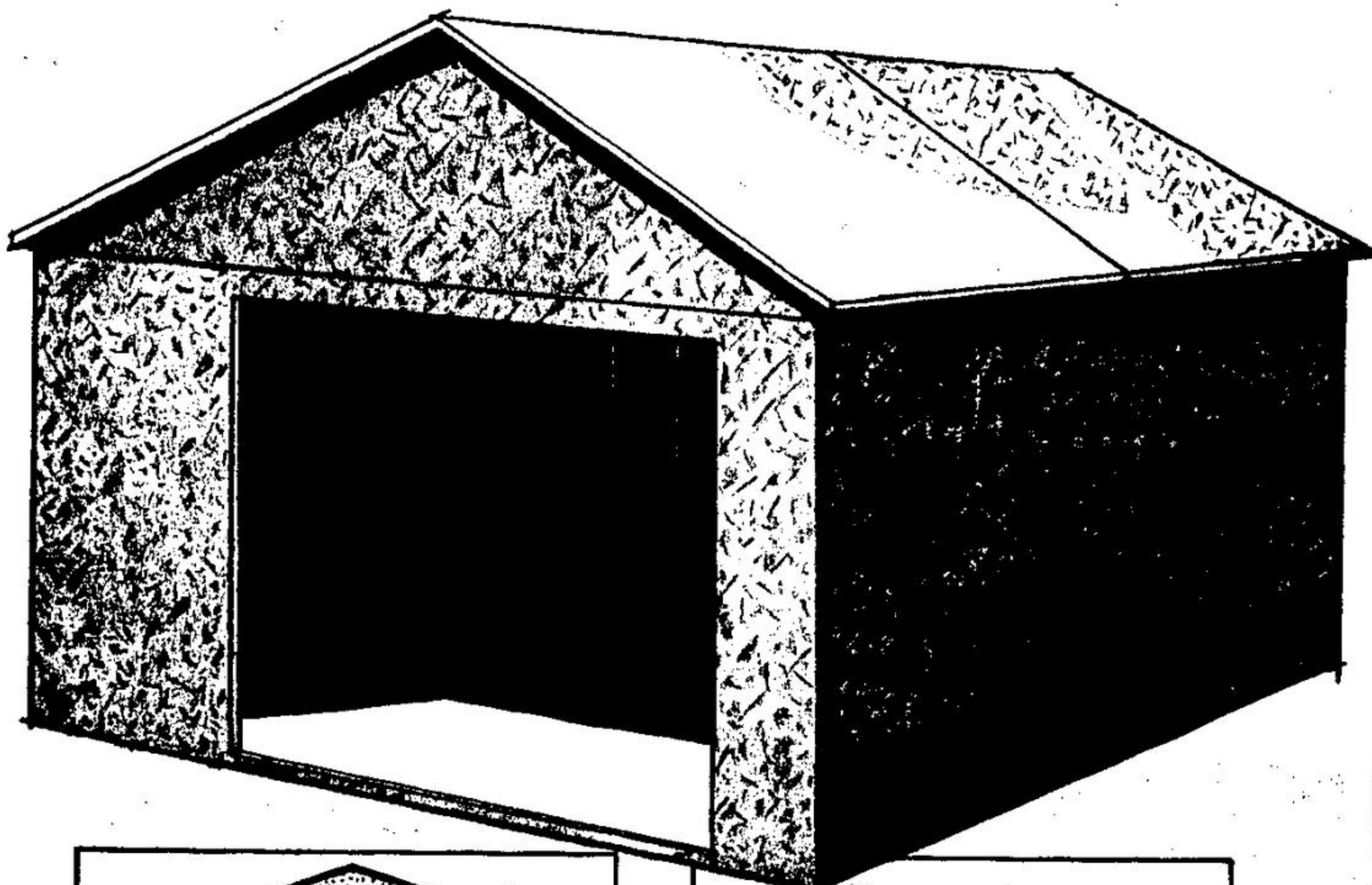
the car as it somersaulted for 150 feet. He is in Wellesley Hospital with head injuries. Bonnie Rimmer, 22, of Toronto, trapped inside the demolished auto was freed by North Halton OPP constable Bill Bourne. She suffered face cuts and a broken thumb. Police found the dead driver and Armstrong lying side by side on the road.



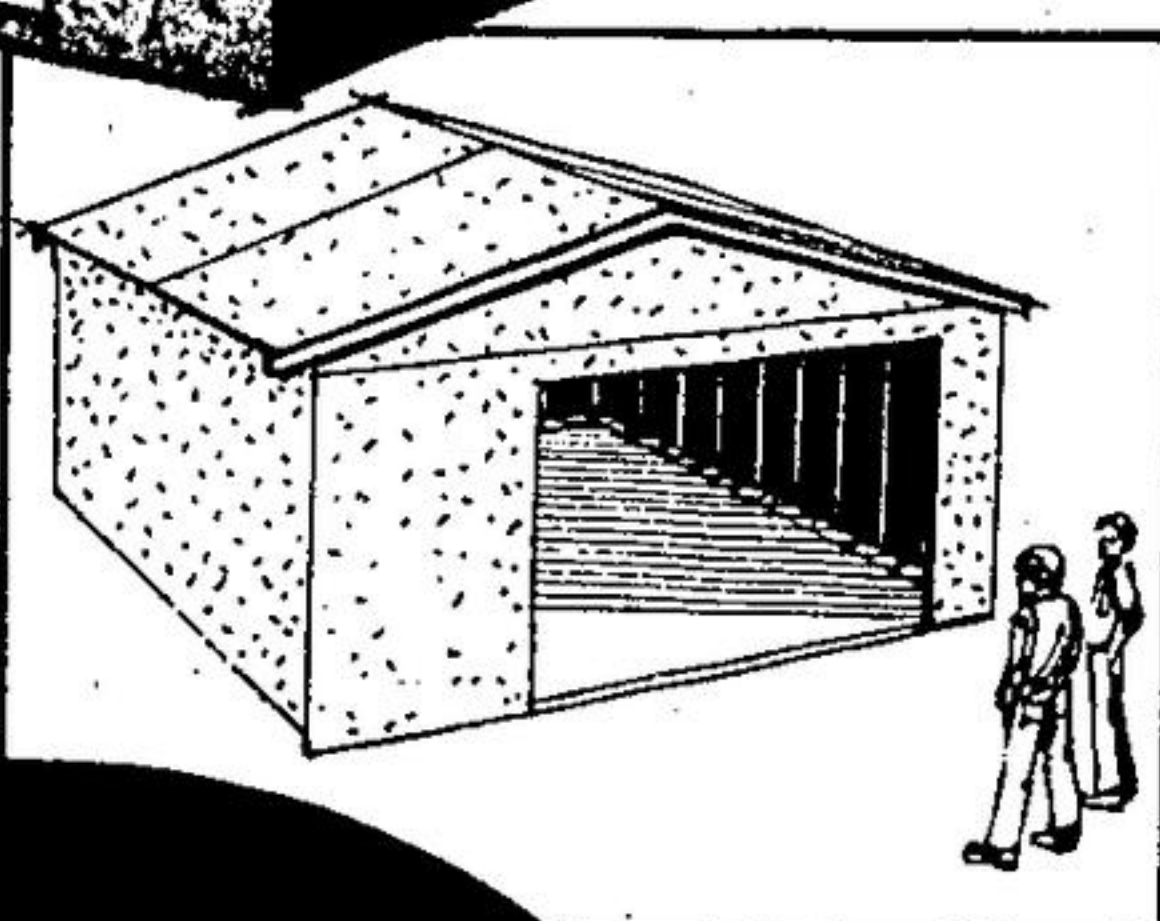
