"The first proposal of the department was for approximately \$150,000 and just involved a double lane reconstruction of Heart Lake Road and Sideroad 10", said Brampton mayor Jim Archdekin. "The new proposal is for construction of four lanes on these roads at a cost of more than a million dollars.




