Circulate Grievance Report to Other Firms

Members of local 967 at Douglas Aircraft met Monday to discuss what measures will be taken now that the UAW offer was rejected by the local members last Thursday.
The local has made arrangements to have a report made and passed to other plants in Ontario stating their grievances against the company and the international union.

Meanwhile, some members of the union are meeting with company executives to discuss the situation. The two are discussing the problem that the international union told them to accept the offer and the local union told them to reject it.
In Long Beach, Calif., almost 1,500 assembly workers at the McDonnell Douglas Corp. have been given two-week layoff notices because of the strike in Malton.
LAYOFFS
The two-week layoffs will begin Nov. 29, company officials said, because the strike in Malton has stopped production of wings for the DC-9 and DC-10 jetliners assembled there.
The Long Beach plant employs some 26,000 workers, officials said. They added that the remaining workers would stay on the job "pending further developments in the six-week Canadian walkout."
